AMENDED BYLAWS (approved February 18, 2009)

CHEDER SCHOLARSHIP ORGANIZATION, INC. (formed under Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Law)

DBA Jewish Education Tax Credit Organization (JETCO)

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Cheder Scholarship Organization, Inc. (the "Corporation.").

ARTICLE II – PURPOSES

- 1. To provide scholarships and tuition grants for qualified students at qualified schools to enable them to attend primary and secondary Jewish schools in Arizona that are Section 501(c)(3) organizations, including the Tucson Hebrew Academy and other Jewish schools in Tucson, AZ.
- 2. To encourage Jewish day school education.
- 3. To encourage continuity in the Jewish community, the study of Torah, the Hebrew language, and Jewish history and philosophy.
- 4. To qualify and operate as a school tuition organization under A.R.S. §§ 43-1089 and 43-1183 as the same may be amended from time to time.
- 5. To all acts and things desirable and necessary to further the objectives of the Corporation.

ARTICLE III – CORPORATE OFFICES

The corporation shall continuously maintain a registered office in this state. Initially the principle office of the Corporation in the State of Arizona shall be the same as its registered office; provided, however, that the Corporation shall have such other offices, either within or without the State of Arizona as the Board of Directors may determine. The registered office in the State of Arizona and the address of the registered office may be, but not need be, identical with the principal office; both such offices may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV - DIRECTORS

- 1. GENERAL POWERS The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. Directors must be residents of the State of Arizona.
- 2. NUMBER AND TENURE The Board of Directors shall consist of up to ten, but not less than three, residents of the State of Arizona who shall serve for a term of two years. Initially the number of Directors shall be ten and shall be the persons identified as Directors in the Articles

of Incorporation of the Corporation. At each annual meeting of the Board of Directors, the Directors shall fill any vacancies not previously filled. At each annual meeting of the Board of Directors held during years ending with an odd number, the Board of Directors shall elect a new slate of Directors which may include Directors then serving as such.

- 3. POWERS The Board of Directors shall be the policy-making body of the Corporation. It shall approve the Corporation's operating budgets and the allocation of scholarships among the educational institutions which are to receive monies from the Corporation; provided, however, that the Corporation shall retain not less than five percent (5%) of all funds received to cover and defray the administrative expenses of the Corporation but shall not retain more than ten percent (10%) of all funds received. The Corporation shall allocate at least ninety percent (90%) of its annual revenues for educational scholarships or tuition grants for Jewish children to attend qualified schools of their parents' choice. Such allocations may include scholarship(s) for more than one year. It shall decide and act on all questions pertaining to the affairs of the Corporation.
- 4. REMOVAL A Director may be removed with or without cause at any time by a two-thirds vote of all Directors at a meeting by the remaining members of the Board in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws governing decisions of its Directors generally.
- 5. RESIGNATIONS; VACANCIES Any Director of the Corporation may resign at any time by giving written notice to the Board of Directors, to the President, or to the Secretary of the Corporation. Such resignation shall take effect at the time specified therein, and unless otherwise specified therein no acceptance of such resignation shall be necessary to make it effective. On the resignation or removal of a Director, the Board shall fill the vacancy. If the resignation or vacancy is in the office of the President then the Vice-President shall assume the office; if it is any other office, the Directors shall elect one of its members to fill such office.
- 6. ACTIONS BY DIRECTORS WITHOUT A MEETING Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board, or by any committee of the Board, may be taken without a meeting if a written consent, or counterpart thereof, setting forth the action so taken, are signed by all of the members of the Board or such committee, as the case may be. Such written consents shall be filed with the minutes of the meetings of the Board or such committee. Such written consents shall have the same force and effect as a unanimous vote at a meeting duly held, and may be stated as such in any certificate or document filed under the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Law. The Board, or any committee of the Board, may also conduct a vote on any matter by e-mail. Any matter proposed by e-mail shall specify a deadline to respond for votes on the matter to be counted. A record of all votes conducted by e-mail shall be included with the minutes of the meetings of the Board or such committee and the results shall have the same force and effect as if held at a regular meeting.
- 7. ANNUAL AND REGULAR MEETINGS An annual meeting of the Board of Directors for the election of Officers and the transaction of other business shall be held before the end of the second month following the close of the Corporation's fiscal year or on such other date as the Directors may specify by resolution. A regular semiannual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held on, or before, the end of the seventh month following the end of the Corporation's fiscal year.

- 8. ADDITIONAL MEETINGS The Board shall have the power to provide for additional regular meetings of the Board at such places, dates, and times as may be determined by the Board. Special meetings of the Board may be called at any time by the President of the Corporation or by any four Directors.
- 9. PLACE OF MEETINGS Meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such places within or outside the State of Arizona as may be fixed by the Board for annual and regular meetings and in the notice of meetings for special meetings.
- 10. NOTICE OF MEETINGS Notice of each annual, regular, or special meeting of the Board shall specify the place, date and time of the meetings, and shall be given to each Director as follows:
 - a. By mail, not less than five (5) business days prior to the date of the meetings; or
 - b. By telephone, telegram, telex, facsimile transmission, e-mail or other electronic media, hand-delivered written message, or in person, in each case not less than three (3) business days prior to the meeting.

A notice of meeting, or waiver of notice, need not specify the business to be transacted at, or the purpose of, any meeting of the Board of Directors.

If given by mail, a notice of meeting shall be deemed to have been given when deposited in the United States Postal Service, with postage thereon prepaid, to each Director at his or her address as it appears in the records kept by the Secretary of the Corporation, or if a Director shall have filed with the Secretary a written request that notices to such Director be mailed to some other address, then directed to such address.

When a meeting of the Board is adjourned to another time and place, it shall not be necessary to give notice of the adjourned meeting if the place, date, and time to which the meeting has been adjourned are announced at the meeting at which the adjournment has been taken, and at the adjourned meeting any business may be transacted that might have been transacted at the original meeting; however, if after the adjournment a new place, date, and time for the adjourned meeting is fixed by the President, , or other acting Chairman of the Board, then a notice of the adjourned meeting shall be given to all Directors, specifying such new place, date, and time in the same manner and in accordance with the same temporal requirements applicable to a notice of an original meeting.

11. WAIVER OF NOTICE – Notice of any meeting of the Board of Directors shall be deemed to have been given to any Director who submits a written waiver of such notice, in person, by mail, by e-mail, or by proxy, whether before or after such meeting. The attendance of any Director at a meeting, in person or by proxy, shall constitute a waiver by such Director of notice of such meeting except where such Director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened.

- 12. QUORUM OF DIRECTORS Except to the extent that a greater percentage is required by law or by the Articles of Incorporation, a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of the Board shall consist of a majority of the total number of Directors (including vacancies), but in no event shall a quorum consist of less than three Directors. Directors present by proxy may be counted for the purpose of establishing the existence of a quorum.
- 13. PROXIES Any Director may, by written or electronic proxy filed with the Secretary of the Corporation, authorize another person or persons to vote on behalf of such Director to action taken without personally attending a meeting. A proxy shall be sufficient if it is in the form of Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, but any proxy which is legally sufficient shall be acceptable even if it is not in the form of Exhibit "A."
- 14. VOTE OF DIRECTORS Whenever any corporate action is to be taken by vote of the Board of Directors, it shall, except as otherwise required by law, by the Articles of Incorporation, or by these Bylaws, be authorized by a majority of the votes cast at a meeting of the Board where there are at least three of the Directors in attendance. Any other reference in these Bylaws to corporate action authorized at a meeting of the Board of "majority vote" or by "two-thirds vote" shall require the action to be authorized by the same percentage of the votes cast at such meeting (rather than by such percentage of the total number of Directors entitled to vote thereon), provided that the affirmative votes cast in favor of any such action be at least equal to the quorum. Blank votes or abstentions shall not be counted in the total number of votes cast.
- 15. MEETINGS BY CONFERENCE TELEPHONE Unless otherwise restricted by law, by the Articles of Incorporation, or by these Bylaws, the Directors or any committee designated by the Board may participate in a meeting of the Board or such committee by means of conference telephone call or any similar communications arrangement by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other at the same time, and participation in a meeting in this manner shall constitute presence in person at the meeting.
- 16. ANNUAL REPORT The Board of Directors shall receive at the annual meeting of the Directors a report, verified by the President and the Treasurer, or by a majority of the Board of Directors, showing in detail the following:
 - a. The assets and liabilities, including trust funds, of the Corporation as of the end of the twelve-month fiscal period ending not more than six (6) months prior to such meeting;
 - b. The material changes in assets and liabilities, including trust funds, during such fiscal period;
 - c. The revenue or receipts of the Corporation, both unrestricted and restricted to particular purpose, during each fiscal period; and
 - d. The expenses and disbursements of the Corporation, for both general and restricted purposes, during such fiscal period.

The annual report shall be filed with the records of the Corporation, and a copy of the abstract thereof shall be entered in the minutes of the proceedings of the annual meeting of the Directors.

- 17. COMMITTEES By resolution adopted by two-thirds of the Directors in office, the Board may designate one or more committees, each of which shall consist of two or more Directors, which committees, to the extent provided in such resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board in the management of the Corporation; but the designation of such committees and the delegation thereto of authority shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors, or any individual director, of any responsibility imposed by law. Other committees, not having and exercising the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Corporation may be designated by a resolution adopted by a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present. Members of such committees, appointed by the President or his designee, shall serve for the period determined by the Directors, or until such committee members resign. Committee members may be removed, with or without cause, by the same vote of the Directors prescribed in this section for the original designation of such committee.
- 18. LIFE DIRECTORS The Board of Directors may, by a resolution adopted by two-thirds of the Directors in office, appoint individuals as honorary Life Directors. Life Directors may attend all meetings of the Board of Directors, but do not have voting privileges and do not count as part of a quorum. Life Directors shall serve indefinitely, but such status may be amended by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

- OFFICERS The Board of Directors shall elect or appoint a President, one or more Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, and such other officers and assistant officers as the Board may determine by resolution, and may give any of them such further designation or alternative titles as it considers to be in the best interest of the Corporation. Two or more offices may be held by the same person except the President and Vice-President may not also hold the office of Secretary.
- 2. PRESIDENT The President shall be the executive head of the Corporation and the Chairman of the Board of Directors. This person shall direct, control, and coordinate the activities of the Corporation either by his, or her, own efforts or through proper delegation of responsibility to the other elected officers of the Corporation. The President shall preside at all meetings, appoint the nominating committee and other special committees, and shall be a member exofficio of all other instruments except where such power may have been expressly delegated by the Board of Directors to another officer.
- 3. VICE-PRESIDENT The Vice-President shall perform the duties of President in his/her absence or during the inability of the President to act, and shall succeed the President in the event of his/her resignation or removal. The Vice-President shall also assist the President in other designated tasks assigned by the President or by these Bylaws.
- 4. SECRETARY The Secretary shall record all the proceedings of the meetings of the Board of Directors and Committees, if any, in a Minute Book to be kept for such purpose and shall send a copy of the Minutes of each Board meeting to each Director as soon thereafter as possible.

The Secretary shall also notify the Directors of meetings in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; and shall act as the custodian of the official files and records of the Corporation.

- 5. TREASURER The Treasurer shall have full charge of the monies and accounts in such banks as the Board of Directors may designate; shall receive and pay out all sums of money paid to or by the Corporation; and issue proper receipts and vouchers. The Treasurer shall also, if required by the Board, give bond in such amount as may be stated and with such sureties as may be demanded for the faithful performance of his/her duties.
- 6. TERM OF OFFICE AND REMOVAL Each Officer shall hold office for the term for which he or she is elected or appointed and until a successor has been elected or appointed and qualified. No Officer may be elected or appointed for a term exceeding one year. Any Officer may be removed by the Board of Directors with or without cause at any time. Removal of an Officer without cause shall be without prejudice to any contract rights that such person may have with respect to the Corporation, but the election or appointment of an Officer shall not of itself create contract rights.
- 7. OTHER OFFICERS The other Officers of the Corporation, if any, shall have such authority and perform such duties in the management of the Corporation as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors and, to the extent so prescribed, as generally pertain to their respective offices, subject to the control of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI – CONTRACTS

- 1. CONTRACTS The President acting for the Board of Directors will enter into and bind the Corporation to contracts pertaining to its affairs and purposes, except where the Board of Directors may delegate such power to another Officer or Board member.
- 2. CHECKS All checks shall be signed by the Treasurer or President or any other Officer designated by the Board of Directors. Checks in excess of a dollar amount set by the Board of Directors from time to time must be signed by the President and Treasurer.
- 3. GIFTS The Board of Directors shall be empowered to accept gifts of money or property made to the Corporation.
- 4. ACCOUNTS All funds shall be deposited in accounts with such bank or banks designated by the Board of Directors.
- 5. INCAPACITY OF SCHOOL ORGANIZATIONS No qualified or any other type of school can bind the Corporation to any fund-raising activity or obligation.

ARTICLE VII – BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Minute Book shall be kept by the Secretary or legal counsel. The book of accounts shall be kept in the custody of the Treasurer, and a current list of Directors shall be maintained by the President.

ARTICLE VIII – FISCAL YEAR

The Corporation's fiscal year shall be the calendar year.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

These Bylaws may be altered, amended, or repealed only by a two-thirds vote of the Directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X - DISSOLUTION

In the event of the Corporation's dissolution, all assets remaining after satisfaction of liabilities shall be distributed as determined by the Board of Directors to other organizations of similar purpose which at that time are exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or equivalent) or the Jewish education institutions that are exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE XI - INDEMNIFICATION

Directors and Officers of the Corporation shall be indemnified to the fullest extend now or hereafter mandated by law (and may be indemnified to the fullest extent now or hereafter permitted by law, subject to the approval of indemnification in such a case by the Board of Directors) for any liabilities arising out of their services to the Corporation or for any services provided to any organization at the request of the Corporation. Persons who are not Directors or Officers of the Corporation may be indemnified with respect to their services to the Corporation to the fullest extent now or hereafter permitted by law with the approval of the Board of Directors. The Corporation may, subject to applicable law, purchase and carry insurance for the indemnification of Directors and Officer of the Corporation and corporate personnel.
