Over 1000 lunches a day Monday through Thursday. Volunteers and Citychurch staff prepare each lunch. The lunches consist of a hot item, fruit, cookies, and popcorn. The bags are loaded into six different trailers and delivered to the neighborhoods that Citychurch ministers in. The lunch is usually met with a smile and excitement from the child who receives it. The children who receive the lunch begin to look forward to it and depend on it. Citychurch also host summer mission groups. Each year Citychurch hosts over 700 missionaries and volunteers who come here to learn about ministry to the inner-city. Lunches are also fed during spring break and some school holidays.

Vans pick children up for breakfast and a children's service and youth service. Groceries are given away to families in attendance and sent home with children who attend. Durning the summer, Citychurch hosts the Jesus Loves You Celebration. It is a citywide crusade with preaching and music, food and fun. Hundreds are fed and ministered to.
