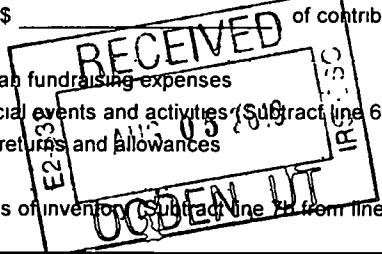



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Angel Spring Missions was incorporated to expand upon two-decades of experience using volunteer teams working in youth detention facilities. These teams present alternate life-styles to incarcerated youths burdened by abuse, drug addiction and gang violence that led to crime. This out-reach program includes fatherhood development, personal counseling, mentoring, special events and aftercare support.

Angel Spring Missions is currently focused upon serving the needs of Ridge View Academy, a youth corrections facility located near Denver, Colorado. The facility serves approximately one-third of the incarcerated young males of the State of Colorado Division of Youth Corrections. Angel Springs' achievements have been recognized by the State of Colorado Department of Human Resources in awarding a grant to continue its parenting and marriage training programs. In addition to the programs previously mentioned, Angel Spring Missions financially and administratively supports Ridge View Academy's Chaplain, Pastor Randall G Cornejo, in serving the spiritual needs of the youth through bible studies, church services and spiritual counseling.

Angel Spring Missions is expanding its programs into the Betty K Marler Center for Girls. This detention facility for young girls is also located near Denver, Colorado. Angel Spring Missions' ambition is to offer its successful programs to similar facilities on a national level.
