GENERAL GRANTING GUIDELINES

The Rizad Foundation may, at its discretion, reimburse qualified individuals for out-of-pocket expenses incurred while volunteering. Individuals requesting a grant must belong to a volunteer organization headquartered in Cowlitz County.

Although the primary mission is directed at the individual volunteer, the Foundation may, at its discretion, make grants to qualified volunteer organizations in Cowlitz County which are seen to benefit the individual volunteers by providing training or equipment which would otherwise not be reasonably available.

At no time is the Rizad Foundation obligated to make grants to any individual or organization and any grants made are totally at the discretion of the Foundation's directors.

RIZAD FOUNDATION GRANT APPLICATION PROCESS

Individuals or organizations requesting grants must meet the following criteria:

1. Individuals must be members of a Rizad approved emergency response unit headquartered in Cowlitz County.
2. The grant must be for individual or organizational expenses incurred while on an authorized activity.
3. If the grant is for other than already expended funds, prior authorization must be obtained before the expenditures are made. This includes, but is not limited to, training and equipment.
4. Individual requested will be authorized by their volunteer organization and forwarded to the Rizad Foundation for consideration.
5. Qualified organizational requests will be forwarded to the Foundation.

A qualified individual is a person who is a member in good standing of an emergency response organization and has incurred an expense while volunteering on an authorized activity. Such expenses must not be eligible for reimbursement through any government agency.

A qualified organization is one on the approved Rizad list.

Grant applications are available through the Cowlitz County Department of Emergency Management website. Fully completed applications will be returned to the Rizad Foundation, P.O. Box 1082, Kelso, Wa. 98626. Grant requests will be considered at the Rizad Foundation's quarterly meetings.
