After learning about and caring for a river stretch in their community, our volunteers become active local voices working to better their waterways and their communities. The Project grew to over 150 volunteers at 120 sites in 2009. CRK utilized the River Communities Project to advocate for strong protections for fish and the Native American and other communities who regularly consume Columbia River fish. The Project includes: 1. Adopt-A-River: CRK recruits volunteers to adopt a section of the Columbia or a local tributary, and work to protect and restore it. Volunteers receive training from CRK staff in how to identify plants, wildlife, water quality, and threats to their section. Volunteers regularly report on their adopted section and identify necessary restoration, which CRK then implements. Over the last three years, we have taught over 1500 school children and 12 classrooms have adopted their own stretch of river. 2. Water Quality Monitoring: CRK trains volunteers to conduct sampling for water clarity, pH, temperature, conductivity (to test for heavy metals presence), and fecal coliform twice per month during sampling season at 120 strategic locations along the Columbia River. The project is coordinated with the Oregon DEQ, which recognizes CRK's data as the highest quality assurance ranking available. This project gives citizens a hands-on way to provide tangible benefits to water quality. CRK conducted Adopt-A-River and Water Quality Monitor trainings in cities across the Columbia River Basin. These events served over 100 people by training new volunteers and refreshing returning volunteers. CRK's water quality monitoring program provides Oregon and Washington state agencies with valuable water quality data, and is used to educate decision makers about water quality problems and in CRK's efforts to reduce pollution and protect

habitat in the basin. In 2009, the Project served over 150 volunteer stewards, who dedicated dozens of hours to the

local waterways and served over 500 students through river and water quality education. The Project also improved water quality and riparian health by placing volunteers to monitor stretches of river, report spills, remove invasive species and trash, and assess habitat value. 990-EZ, PAGE 2, PART III, LINE 29: basic right for all people to utilize the Columbia River. This will require a large reduction in toxic discharges into the Columbia. CRK uses science-based advocacy, grass roots organizing, and legal enforcement of environmental laws to work toward this goal. CRK works with state & Federal agencies to strengthen water quality laws, which protect human health and aquatic habitat. In 2009, CRK participated in several state and federal work groups designed to address toxic discharges and to protect a wider spectrum of people from toxic exposure due to eating fish and other water related activies. CRK assisted in the production of the 2009 State of the River Report published by the US Environmental Protection Agency's Columbia River Toxics Reduction Workgroup. CRK also continued its advocacy for the thorough clean up of the Hanford Nuclear Site, which is the most contaminated place in the western hemisphere. CRK reviewed technical documents and produced action alerts and issue briefings for our members and the general public and organized citizen attendance & testimony at multiple hearings regarding important Hanford clean up issues. CRK distributed over 500 copies of our educations book "Hanford and the River." and conducted 3 educational paddle trips down the Hanford Reach of the Columbia. In 2009, we also reviewed over 40 proposed pollution permits on the Columbia River and its tributaries and prepared detailed evaluations and written comments when necessary. While impossible to quantify the pollutant load reductions we expect, we have obtained pollutant load reductions of 50 % or more from reviewing and commenting on proposed permits and expect similar results for this review 990-EZ, PAGE 2, PART III, LINE 30: Condit Dam, which will restore salmon to miles of previously blocked spawning streams. In 2009, CRK also utilized sampling probes and temperature loggers to understand key refuges for salmon, and provided the temperature data to Oregon and Washington agencies to help guide management decisions. In addition, CRK worked to protect salmon nurseries in the Columbia River estuary from harmful dredging and wetland fill associated with two proposed Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) terminals and their associated pipelines. CRK helped organize a large and diverse coalition of people fighting to protect salmon habitat, forests and farms. In 2009, we served over 300 volunteers by providing action alerts, information updates, opportunities to contact elected leaders, rallies, and educational events. In 2009, CRK was successful in restoring Clatsop County land use protections that had been overturned due to the LNG application. CRK also joined Oregon and Washington, &the Nez Perce Tribe in appealing the federal government's approval of an LNG terminal.
