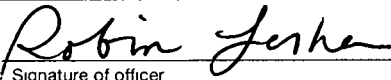

In May 2013, I became the new Treasurer of Northwest Scientific Association. In assembling data for filing return for 2013 Form 990EZ and Schedule A, it became apparent that gross revenues for recent years exceeded \$50,000.

The previous Treasurer had submitted Form 990N for those recent years. Complete data records were only available beginning in 2009, so am not able to provide values for Lines 1-13 columns a-d (2005-2008), Lines 16 and 18.

This form 990EZ, Schedule A and the attachment comprise the amended return for 2009
