

We have one full time staff person dedicated to membership with support staff allocated for a portion of their time to build, support and grow our membership. Membership support includes the directory, the website, LEAD Partnerships, quarterly newsletters, electronic E-News, Capital Notes and leadership, advocacy, training, connectivity for and to our members.

Board Support: The organization is led by an almost 80 person Board of Directors and a 10 member Executive Committee. The full Board meets quarterly at the end of each of our membership meetings. Board support includes staff time, travel, meals, facility rentals, printing of board packets, telecommunications services for Board members to meet electronically and training facilitation opportunities.
