Through educational and outreach initiatives, Black United Fund increases awareness to social, economic, and cultural significance of philanthropy, builds the capacity of individuals to give, and encourages greater philanthropic awareness. People benefited from grants and allocations to other agencies. Long-term goals include the establishment of a multipurpose cultural and educational institution that will highlight the culture, history and contributions of African-Americans, and provide space for small nonprofits and small business owners. During the year ended December 31, 2009, 71,592 people benefitted from grants and allocations; 176 benefitted from non-prof workshops; and 59 agencies received grants.	of
