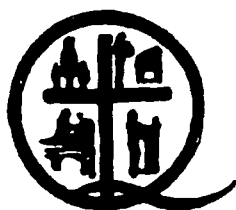

1) The General Fund




