The Seto Foundation Statement of Policies

Approved July 7, 2009

BACKGROUND

. . . .

The Seto Foundation (The Foundation) was founded in September 1996 in Honolulu, Hawaii as a private foundation under the Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3).

The Foundation Directors recognize that the measure of success that has been achieved by its founders bestows upon them a responsibility to "give back" to the community. Therefore, it is the express desire of the Foundation that its Directors become actively involved in the charitable community.

I. GOVERNANCE

1.1 Directors meetings. Directors meetings are generally held in the evenings twice a year.

1.2 Conflicts of interest.

- a) Purpose of the Statement of Policy: The Seto Foundation is committed to integrity and fairness in all of its activities. Inevitably, the interests of the Directors will involve them in organizations, causes, and other endeavors that intersect with the affairs of the Foundation. It would disadvantage the Foundation to deprive it of the involvement of interested colleagues, but their participation in Foundation decision-making cannot impair the fairness and integrity of Foundation processes. This statement of principle is intended to further the work of the Foundation by facilitating the substantive contributions of its Directors through providing for disclosure of other interests and by requiring abstention from decision-making actions that affect non-foundation affiliations or interests. In addition, the Foundation would suffer if there were any appearance of bias or self-interest in its activities. These principles are intended to preclude any such appearance.
- b) **Disclosure:** Directors of the Foundation will communicate fully with the Foundation regarding any relationship or commitment that could affect the impartial fulfillment of their role in the affairs of the Foundation. This policy refers to such a relationship or commitment as affiliation. Affiliation may be defined as the close involvement with a vendor, service provider, or grantee on the part of (a) a Director of the Foundation or (b) the spouse or equivalent, parents, or children of a Director. Affiliation includes, but is not limited to, serving as a board member, employee, or consultant to a current or potential grantee, service provider, or vendor, or doing business with the grantee, service provider, or vendor. In principle, extra-foundation affiliations or interests should be disclosed to other participants in the foundation's decision-making process whenever there is any doubt about whether disclosure is required.

- c) **Abstention from Foundation Decision-making:** In all situations in which disclosure of affecting relationships should be made, the Foundation-affiliated individual should abstain from decision-taking actions, and that abstention should be formally noted in the Foundation's minutes. With disclosure to other participants, the work of the Foundation is furthered by the willingness of its Direct ors, however interested, to share information bearing upon the matter under consideration. Such participation is encouraged.
- d) **No Return Benefit:** In considering any decision regarding an organization or person with which a Foundation Director is affiliated, the Foundation shall avoid any transaction that results in any direct or indirect economic benefit to the affiliated person or that would constitute self-dealing under Internal Revenue Code Section 4941. Incidental and tenuous benefits to affiliated persons, such as name recognition or public acknowledgment, are permitted. No grant shall be made from the Foundation to satisfy a personal pledge made by a Director.
- e) **Gifts:** The Director shall not accept a gift or gratuity, except of nominal value, from any past or present grantee. Directors may represent the Foundation at events sponsored by a grantee to recognize the contributions of the Foundation.
- f) **Avoid the Appearance of Conflict:** While the substance of integrity is the essence of the Foundation's approach to these matters, avoiding the appearance of conflict is an important collateral objective. To that end, the Foundation will not customarily make grants to, or contract with, organizations that employ affiliated persons
- **1.3 Director compensation.** The Directors shall receive no compensation for their services. However, they shall be entitled to the reimbursement of expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as directors.

II. MANAGEMENT

- 2.1 Fiscal year. The Foundation's fiscal year runs from January 1 through December 31.
- **2.2 Investment Objective**. The investment objective of the foundation is to achieve an annual rate of total return (income and capital appreciation) of at least 5%. In seeking to achieve the objective, the monies of the Foundation will be invested in a balanced portfolio of securities with an appropriate level of risk and in accordance with all applicable Federal and Hawaii Statues and regulations governing the investment of private foundations.
- **2.3 Investment Responsibility.** The Board of Directors (Directors) shall be responsible for the investments held by the Foundation. Its duties shall include establishing investment policies and guidelines, managing the investment portfolio, and reviewing the investments and their performance on a periodic basis. The Directors may hire investment professionals to assist them in fulfilling their investment responsibilities. The Directors

shall monitor the activities of such professionals to ensure that their actions are in accordance with the policies, procedures, and guidelines of the foundation.

- **2.4 Fiscal management.** First Hawaiian Bank holds all the Foundation's assets in custody and is the Foundation's fiscal manager. Written investment guidelines and asset allocation, adopted from time to time by the Directors, are maintained at First Hawaiian Bank with copies held at the Hawaii Community Foundation. Asset allocation is to be reviewed periodically by the Directors, in collaboration with the Foundation's investment consultant.
- **2.5 Spending guidelines**. The Foundation will pay out in disbursements for charitable purposes (grants plus allocated expenses as defined in the return of Private Foundation form 990-PF)an amount equal to approximately 5% of the market value of the portfolio, averaged over the previous twelve (12) months. For budgetary purposes, an amount is to be set for the current year based on 5% of the market value as of the last day of each month for twelve (12) months up to and including December 31 of the prior year. The Foundation's Board of Directors may adjust the amount at its discretion. Annually, the Certified Public Accountant firm will report on whether the Foundation can reduce its tax liability from 2% to 1% by making additional grants.

III. GRANTMAKING

- **3.1 Grants administration:** Hawaii Community Foundation provides grants administration services for the Foundation. The Foundation Directors approve an annual contract with HCF for a set of services and fee. The fee is paid twice a year in January and July.
- **3.2 Mission.** The mission of The Seto Foundation is to improve the human condition through the promotion of health, education, safety and welfare of the members of the community.
- **3.3 Priorities:** While not restricting grants to any particular field, the Foundation has a particular interest in organizations that will:
 - Improve the human condition by helping people to help themselves
 - Perpetuate the well-being of women and children by supporting health, family and educational programs
 - Provide essential services for people who cannot reasonably provide for themselves
 - Provide rehabilitation and reintegration programs to people in need
 - Promote high quality early education and parenting skills
 - Promote advances of medical science to benefit the community
 - Promote the arts as a means to improve the human condition
 - Provide educational opportunities for deserving students through scholarships

3.4 Funding eligibility and guidelines

a) Applicants must have a 501 (c)(3) tax exempt public charity status or must work through a fiscal sponsor with 501(c)(3) status. The Foundation does not make

- grants to organizations classified as 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or any other organizations that would require the Foundation to exercise expenditure responsibility.
- b) The Foundation intends to give maximum flexibility to the Directors as they seek deserving organizations to support so is open to a variety of types of grants including capital improvements, operating support, and project or programmatic support. The Foundation generally does not fund loans, lobbying, funds for regranting or grants to individuals or for the benefit of identified individuals (except support to educational institutions for scholarships)
- c) Unsolicited proposals from grant seeking organizations are not generally considered.
- d) The Foundation recognizes that in order to be successful in accomplishing its purposes, a charitable organization must have community support rather than relying solely on foundation or government funding. For this reason, the Directors will pay particular attention to how active members of the organization's board of directors are in carrying out their responsibilities to the organization.

 Organizations are expected to have active and contributing volunteer leadership.
- e) Additional factors in consideration of support include:
 - Demonstrated community need for the proposed project or the organization as a whole (in the case of general operating support)
 - Qualifications of staff and/or volunteers to carry out the proposed project or organization's operations
 - Ability to measure effectiveness of the project or organization
 - · Reasonableness of the project or organization's budget
 - Sustainability of the project or organization beyond the grant award
- f) The Hawaii Community Foundation staff provide the Directors with recommendations regarding potential grants. Staff will work with potential grantee organizations to gather the information on the organization, program, staff and budget.
- g) Only organizations awarded funding will be notified of the Directors' funding decisions.
- **3.5 Directors Interests**. The following organizations do not require review by Hawaii Community Foundation, however, final reports are still required:
 - Hanahau`oli School
 - Iolani School
 - Punahou School
 - The Early School
 - University of Puget Sound
- 3.6 Terms and conditions. Grants are subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a) Grantees must use the grant only for the purpose designated.
 - b) Grantees must submit a final report no later than thirteen months after the date of the award letter.

- c) The Foundation reserves the right to conduct site visits and to require interim reports.
- d) Grantees must report any unexpended funds remaining at the end of the grant period and return unexpended funds.
- e) Grantees must notify the foundation immediately if they cannot perform in accordance with the terms of the grant, materially change their mission or activities, or lose exemption from federal income taxes under section 501 (c)(3). In these circumstances, grantees may be required to return their grant.
- **3.7 Final Reports** Accountability is emphasized. The Foundation requires that its grantees provide documentation showing that funds received were administered in accordance with the grant agreement letter and grant guidelines. All funded organizations are required to submit a final grant report. This report is to include a financial statement for the period in which the grant monies were spent, and a narrative section describing the outcomes of the funded project. Final report criteria are included in the grant agreement letter. Organizations not submitting timely reports or not expending funds as agreed may be disqualified from future grant consideration.
