To stay clean and sober, he must literally find a new way to live. The New Life Manor program is available to adult alcoholism/chemically dependent men in need of a living environment that is supportive of recovery. The New Life Program is a 24 bed men's community residence that provides a bridge between intensive treatment and sober independent living.
