## EXHIBIT A AMENDED BYLAWS

#### **BY-LAWS**

#### OF

#### THE DRISCOLL FOUNDATION

- 1. <u>Corporate name and seal</u> The name of the corporation is The Driscoll Foundation, and its corporate seal is as set forth in the impression annexed hereto.
- 2. <u>Corporate purpose and limitations thereof</u> The corporate purpose is as stated and limited in the Articles of Incorporation.
- 3. <u>Registered office</u> The registered office of the corporation shall be located in Saint Paul, Minnesota, and until otherwise ordered by the board of directors, shall be at W-2191 First National Bank Building, Saint Paul, Minnesota.

#### 4. Membership -

- (a) <u>Composition</u> Members of the corporation shall consist of the original incorporators and such additional members, without limitation as to number, as may from time to time be elected by a majority vote of the members present in person or by proxy at any annual or special meeting of the members at which a quorum is present.
- (b) One class of members; voting rights There shall be but one class of members, and each member shall be entitled to one vote.
- (c) <u>Resignation</u> Any member may resign by delivering a written resignation to the president or secretary of the corporation.
- (d) Removal Any member may be removed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the full membership, registered either in person or by proxy, at any regular or special meeting called for that purpose, for conduct detrimental to the interests of the corporation, for lack of sympathy with its objectives or for refusal to render reasonable assistance in carrying out its purposes. Any member proposed to be removed shall be entitled to at least five days' notice in writing, by mail, of the meeting at which such removal is to be voted upon and shall be entitled to appear before and be heard at such meeting.
- (e) <u>Effect of termination</u> All rights of a member shall cease on the termination of his membership.

#### 5. Meetings of members

(a) Annual meeting - An annual meeting of the members shall be held on the first Thursday after the last Saturday in January of each year for the purpose of electing directors and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting. When the annual meeting has not been held, or directors have not been elected thereat, directors may be

elected at a special meeting held for that purpose. Upon demand of any member, the president, or secretary shall call the special meeting.

- (b) Special meetings Special meetings of the members may be called at any time, for any purpose, by (a) the president, (b) the board of directors, or (c) one-third of the members. A person entitled to call a special meeting may make a written request to the president or secretary to call the meeting. Such officer shall give notice of the meeting to be held between ten and forty days after receiving the request. If the officer fails to give notice of the meeting within seven days from the date on which the request was made, the person who requested the meeting may call the meeting, fixing the time in the manner provided by these by-laws and giving notice thereof.
- (c) <u>Place of meetings</u> Meetings of the members shall be held at any place within or without the State of Minnesota designated by the board of directors, and in the absence of such designation shall be held at the registered office of the corporation.
- (d) Notice of meetings Notice of every annual and every special meeting, stating the time, place and purpose thereof, shall be mailed to each member not less than five nor more than forty days before such meeting, directed to each member at his address as it appears on the records of the corporation.
- (e) <u>Quorum requirements</u> A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting of members. When a quorum is not present, any meeting may be adjourned from time to time for that reason.
- (f) <u>Proxies</u> -Proxies shall be permitted at all meetings. The appointment of a proxy shall be in writing filed at or before the meeting with the secretary of the corporation or the person who has been designated to act as secretary of the meeting.
- (g) <u>Voting</u> Each member shall have one vote. There shall be no cumulative voting. Members may vote by voice or by ballot.
- (h) <u>Adjournment</u> When a meeting of the members is adjourned to another time or place, notice of the adjourned meeting need not be given other than by announcement at the meeting at which adjournment is taken.
- (i) Action without a meeting Any action that may be taken at a meeting of the members may be taken without a meeting if authorized in a writing signed by all the members who are entitled to notice of a meeting called for the purpose of taking such action.
- (j) <u>Irregular meetings; validation</u> When written consent of all the members who were entitled to notice of a meeting has been obtained, an irregular meeting, with any action taken at such meeting, is validated.

#### 6. Directors -

(a) <u>Board</u> - The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of not less than three nor more than fifteen directors, as the members shall from time to time determine.

- (b) <u>Qualifications</u> Directors shall be persons of full age, but need not be members of the corporation or residents of Minnesota.
- (c) <u>Election and tenure</u> The members shall elect the directors. The term of office of directors is one year. A director shall hold office for the term for which he has been elected and until his successor has been elected and qualified, except in cases of resignation or removal.
- election, the newly elected directors may meet forthwith for the purpose of organization, the election of officers and the transaction of any other business of which special notice is not required by law or by these by-laws, and if a quorum of the directors be then present, no notice of such meeting shall be required. The place and time of such first meeting may, however, be fixed by written consent of all the directors by notice to all directors as in the case of a special meeting. Special meetings of the board of directors may be called by the president or secretary of the corporation and must be called by either of them on the written request of any two members of the board. Notice of all directors meetings, except as herein otherwise provided, shall be given by mailing the same at least three days, or by telegraphing the same at least one day, before the meeting, to the usual business or residence address of the director. Special meetings shall be held at any place within or without the State of Minnesota designated by the board of directors, and in the absence of such designation shall be held at the registered office of the corporation.
  - (e) Quorum A majority of the directors shall constitute a quorum
- (f) <u>Vacancies</u> The remaining members of the board, though less than a quorum, shall fill any vacancy occurring on the board. A person so selected shall hold office until his successor has been elected and qualified.
- (g) <u>Removal</u> The members, by a majority vote of those entitled to vote at an election of directors, may, with or without cause, remove a director or the entire board from office. Neither a director nor the entire board shall be removed from office unless the notice of the annual or special meeting at which removal is, to be considered states such purpose. When the board or a director has been removed, new directors may be elected at the same meeting.
- (h) Executive committee The board of directors may designate two or more of its members to constitute an executive committee. To the extent determined by the board, the executive committee has the authority of the board in the management of the business of the corporation. The executive committee shall act only in the interval between meetings of the board and at all times shall be subject to the control and direction of the board.
- (i) Board action without a meeting Any action that could be taken at a meeting of the board of directors may be taken without a meeting when authorized in writing signed by all of the directors.

#### 7. Officers -

- (a) <u>Designation and election</u> The officers of the corporation shall be the president, secretary, treasurer, and such other officers with such powers and duties as may be determined by the board of directors. The officers shall be elected annually by the board of directors at the first meeting of the board after the annual meeting of members. Any officer so elected shall hold office until the first meeting of the board of directors after the annual meeting of members next succeeding and until the election and qualification of his successor, except in cases of resignation or removal.
- (b) <u>Qualifications</u> Officers shall be of full age, but need not be members or directors of the corporation. The same person shall not at the same time hold the offices of president and secretary, but he may hold any other two offices at the same time.
- (c) <u>Removal</u> An officer may be removed, with or without cause, by the board of directors.
- (d) <u>President</u> The president shall serve as the chair of the board of directors and shall preside at all meetings of members and of the board of directors and shall have and exercise general charge and supervision of the affairs of the corporation, and do and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the board of directors.
- (e) <u>Secretary</u> The secretary shall have charge of the records of the corporation and the custody of the corporate seal and in general shall perform all the duties incident to the office of secretary, subject to the control of the board of directors, and do and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the board of directors.
- (f) <u>Treasurer</u> The treasurer shall have custody of all funds, property and securities of the corporation, subject to such regulations as may be imposed by the board of directors, and shall in general perform all the duties incident to the office of treasurer, subject to the control of the board of directors.
- 8. <u>Waivers of notice</u> A director or member may waive notice of any meeting and notice of the business to be transacted at such meeting, before, at or after such meeting. The waiver shall be- in writing, filed with the person who has been designated to act as secretary of the meeting, who shall enter it upon the records of the meeting. Appearance at a meeting is deemed a waiver unless it is solely for the purpose of asserting the illegality of the meeting.
- 9. Receiving, holding and investing trust property Within the scope of the corporate purposes and subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 501.12 (relating to trusts for charitable, educational, religious and other uses) the corporation may take, receive and hold real and personal property, including the principal and interest of any money or other fund, that is given, conveyed, bequeathed, devised to or otherwise vested in the corporation in trust for a purpose consistent with the purposes set forth in its Articles. Except where the trust instrument prescribes otherwise, the corporation may invest trust property or its proceeds in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 501.125.

- 10. Certain records The corporation shall keep at its registered office correct and complete books of account and minutes of proceedings of meetings of (a) the members, (b) the board of directors and (c) all committees having any of the authority of the board of directors. A member, acting in person or by agent or attorney, may inspect all books and records for any proper purpose at any reasonable time. Upon the request of any member, the corporation shall furnish such member with a statement showing the financial result of all operations and transactions affecting income and surplus during its last annual accounting period and a balance sheet containing a summary of its assets and liabilities as of the closing date of such accounting period.
- of directors, the president shall have the power, on behalf of the corporation, to vote either in person or by proxy at any meeting of stockholders of any corporation in which this corporation may hold stock, and at any such meeting shall possess and may exercise all of the rights and powers incident to the ownership of such stock which, as the owner thereof, this corporation might have possessed and exercised if present. The board of directors may confer like powers upon any other person and may revoke any such powers at its pleasure.
  - 12. Amendment of By-Laws The by-laws may be amended in manner as follows:
- (a) The board of directors shall propose the amendment by resolution setting forth the proposed amendment and directing that it be submitted for adoption at a meeting of the members called for such purpose.
- (b) Notice of the meeting of members, stating the purpose, shall be given to each member entitled to vote on the proposed amendment and to each officer and director regardless of his voting rights.
- (c) At such meeting or any adjournment thereof, the proposed amendment may be adopted by affirmative vote of a majority of the members voting.
