APPLICATIONS FOR GRANTS PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

THE WHITE FUND, INC.

The principal purposes of The White Fund are to sponsor a lecture series and to support the Lawrence Public Library. To the extent that annual income exceeds expenses for these principal purposes, the remainder of the income is to support the moral and intellectual advancement and education of the residents of the City of Lawrence, particularly among young people.

Applications will be accepted at any time during the Fund's fiscal year (April 1st through March 31st). Proposals will be reviewed and voted upon at the Trustees' meetings during that year, and should be accompanied by the following information and documentation.

1. Statements of the organizational background, the purposes and objectives of the organization and a list of the officers and Board of Directors of the organization.
2. Copy of current year projected budget, project budget if requesting funding for a special project, together with the latest Annual Report (Auditor's Report if available).
3. Statement of sources of financial support, including grants or anticipated grants from other trusts or foundations.
