



GUIDELINES SUMMARY

The Greater Hartford Automobile Dealers Association Foundation awards grants to non profit organizations which are based in the Greater Hartford Area and which serve community needs primarily in the areas of culture, the arts, the needy and the homeless through sponsorship of special programs and projects which enhance the quality of life in Greater Hartford. The Greater Hartford area is defined for this purpose as a town in Hartford County or a town immediately contiguous to Hartford County. Most grants are single year awards, with multi-year funding considered in exceptional cases.

Monies may be awarded for support of a program, capital and operating expenses, as seed money or as challenge or matching grants. Contributions are not made to individuals; veterans, fraternal, professional or business associations; religious institutions, other than for their provision of non-sectarian educational or social service programs open to the community; private foundations; political or lobbying groups and groups lacking evidence of tax exempt status under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The Greater Hartford Automobile Dealers Association Foundation Board of Directors meets annually with application deadline being **March 26, 2010**.



GREATER HARTFORD AUTOMOBILE DEALERS ASSOCIATION FOUNDATION, INC.

The Greater Hartford Automobile Dealers Association Foundation, Inc. shall provide assistance mainly to charitable, educational and cultural organizations serving the residents of Greater Hartford, specifically in Hartford County and the towns immediately contiguous to Hartford County. The Board of Directors currently prefers to make contributions to institutions and organizations serving community needs in the areas of culture and the arts, and the needy and homeless through sponsorship of special programs and projects which enhance the quality of life in Greater Hartford.

GRANTS

In general, the Foundation will make both one time and continuing grants. Continuing grants which are renewed each year shall be made only to a limited number of organizations which seem to be making unique contributions in their respective fields.

DURATION OF GRANTS

No grant made by the Foundation carries any implication of automatic renewal in subsequent years. Exceptions are grants payable over several years on a specified schedule.

FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION

There are many worthwhile organizations eligible for grants, and the Foundation's financial capacity is not sufficient to meet all the requests for funds. Therefore, the Foundation will not reconsider a request that has been turned down, until a period of twelve months has passed.

GRANT RESTRICTIONS

No grants shall be made to any of the following:

- Groups lacking evidence of tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code
- Individuals
- Religious institutions other than those providing nonsectarian health, educational and social services to the community
- Veterans, fraternal, professional and business associations
- Member agencies of federated councils (e.g. United Way, Combined Health Appeal, Greater Hartford Arts Council) except for capital campaigns and special grants for programs and projects which may be considered separately by the Foundation Board of Directors
- Organizations created to influence the outcome of partisan or non-partisan electoral contests including political parties and other groups supporting or opposing particular candidates or ballot measures
- Organizations actively and regularly engaged in influencing legislation
- Private foundations

HOW TO APPLY FOR A GRANT

Before submitting an application please study the guidelines of the Greater Hartford Automobile Dealers Association Foundation to be sure that the purpose for which your organization seeks funds is one which is appropriate for consideration. If there is any doubt as to the suitability of your request, please call the Foundation office. Foundation staff will be pleased to advise and assist any organization planning to apply for a grant of funds.

Please fill out the attached form, responding to the specific questions in the spaces provided. Be sure that the application is signed by the agency director and the head of the board of directors. Attach the following items:

- Organization Chart
- List of officers and members of governing board
- List of organization's current supporters and level of assistance for each
- Copy of most recent audit
- Program report for latest completed year, indicating activities and number of persons served

Concise description of program for which funding is being requested - Including but not limited to:

- Evidence of need for program
- Program goals, including population and number to be served
- Program activities
- Names and qualifications of staff who will be carrying out program
- Timetable for Program
- Information on how program will be evaluated
- Plans for funding beyond this grant period
- Detailed program budget, including potential and committed sources of income

If your program involves presentations to benefit a specific population, such as disadvantaged student or career training for the needy and homeless, please include written verification from appropriate authorities involved with the target population group, i.e. school officials, representatives of state commissions or agencies. You may include any other material you feel will clarify or strengthen your request.

All applicants whose grant requests have been rejected will be notified by letter from the Foundation. All grants which are awarded by the Foundation will be paid by check.

Although the Foundation prefers to give support at significant levels, grants of less than \$1000.00 will be considered.

Before a grant application is referred to the Board of Directors for consideration, it will be studied by the Foundation staff for its completeness. The staff or individual directors may meet with the grant applicant to clarify any points and if appropriate, with other agencies in the same related fields, community leaders and persons knowledgeable about the need to which the application is addressed.
