	Rally Foundation supports all phases of childhood cancer research from science at the bench (very early research) to Phase I, II, and III clinical trials including targeted therapies, DNA studies and survivorship studies. Rally Foundation is also excited to help fund the collaborative research of more than 5,000 physicians, scientists and nurses at 200 hospitals nationwide. These physicians and nurses treat more than 90% of the children in the US with cancer. Eighty percent of these children are enrolled in clinical trials. Rally gives research grants once a year during its fiscal year fourth quarter - January through March. In 2009-2010, Rally Foundation funded 21 such grants, bringing it's total grants to just over \$1,600,000 supporting 45 research projects.
