major community health issues. For more than a decade, about \$500,000 has been granted annually to community-based projects addressing racial and ethnic inequities and root causes. These dollars are in addition to Legacy's other charitable contributions. The Community Health Fund has provided 38 grants since 1999 totaling more than \$5.8 million. Recognizing that education, employment and income inequities exist for communities of diversity, and that health professions are lacking in diversity, Legacy established the Youth Employment in Summer program. African American and Hispanic youth receive paid summer employment in departments where they worked with health professionals and earned college scholarships between \$2,500 and \$5,000 annually. Students can remain in the program as long as they stay in school and pursued healthcare careers. Some students have remained in this program for as long as seven years and graduated with degrees in a variety of healthcare fields. Legacy encourages and supports employee volunteerism. Legacy donates \$100 to nonprofit health, human service or education organizations in honor of employees who volunteer on personal time 50 hours a year Employees may receive paid time when volunteering in one or two week time periods in local nonprofit organizations through Legacy's community services leave program Non-cash donations of resources include clinical and non-clinical services and items, e.g., screenings and support services, internships, information and referral services and health fairs. Legacy's warehouse is open to nonprofit organizations to obtain surplus equipment and furniture. In addition, conference room space is made available to local nonprofits for Board and community meetings LSCH has recognized that nonprofit organizations spend valuable dollars on office space and infrastructure - dollars better spent on meeting their missions. As a result, LSCH has provided free office space and other infrastructure services to nonprofit organizations on its campus.
