BYLAWS

OF

WINONA AREA PUBLIC SCHOOLS TOUCHDOWN CLUB

ARTICLE 1

Registered Office

The Official name of this organization shall be Winona Area Public Schools Touchdown Club.

ARTICLE 2

Membership

SECTION 2.1 <u>Voting members</u>, This corporation shall have members with voting rights. Individuals who desire to become members of this corporation shall become members of this corporation by applying for such membership and by paying the annual dues in advance.

SECTION 2.2 <u>Dues</u>. The Board of Directors shall have the right to determine the dues or other payments to be made by the members of this corporation from time to time. The membership year for the members of this corporation shall be the same as the fiscal year of this corporation. The annual dues will be \$1.00. Payment may be made after the annual meeting, however voting rights will not go into affect until the next scheduled meeting.

SECTION 2.3 <u>Interest in property</u>. The members of this corporation shall not, as such, have any right, title or interest in the real or personal property of this corporation.

SECTION 2.4 <u>Resignation</u>. Any member may resign his, her or its membership at any time by giving written notice to the Board of Directors or to the Secretary. Such resignation shall take effect at the date of the receipt of such notice or at any later time specified therein; and, unless otherwise specified therein, the acceptance of such resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective. Any member who resigns his or her membership shall not be entitled to a refund of any dues or other payments made to this corporation.

SECTION 2.5 <u>Termination</u>. Any membership may be terminated by the Board of Directors by providing the member with not less than fifteen (15) days written notice of the proposed termination and the reasons for it, and with an opportunity to be heard, orally or in writing, not less than five (5) days before the effective date of the proposed termination by a person authorized to decide whether the termination shall take place.

ARTICLE 3

Meetings of Members

SECTION 3.1 <u>Annual meeting</u>. The annual meeting of the members of this corporation for the election of directors, the presentation of reports on the activities and financial condition of this corporation, and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting, shall be held at such time in the month of March in each year as may be designated from time to time by the Board of Directors and at the place, within or without the State of Minnesota, designated from time to time by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 3.2 Special meetings. Special meetings of the members of this corporation may be called at any time (a) by the President, (b) by the Board of Directors, or (c) upon written request of at least five (5) percent of the members of this corporation. Anyone entitled to call a special meeting of the members may make written request to the President to call the meeting, and the Secretary shall then give notice of the meeting, setting forth the time, place and purpose thereof, to be held no later than twenty (20) days after receiving the request. If the Secretary fails to give notice of the meeting within ten (10) days from the date on which the request is received by the President, the person or persons who requested the meeting may fix the time and place of the meeting and give notice thereof in the manner hereinafter provided. If a special meeting is demanded by the members, the meeting shall be held in the county where the registered office is located. The business transacted at a special meeting is limited to the purposes stated in the notice of the meeting.

SECTION 3.3 <u>Notice</u>. Written notice of each meeting of the members, stating the time and place thereof, shall be e-mailed or posted on the WSHS district website not less than five nor more than sixty days before the meeting, excluding the day of the meeting, to each member of this corporation.

SECTION 3.4 <u>Voting</u>; <u>quorum</u>. At all meetings of the members, each member shall be entitled to cast one vote on any question coming before the meeting. The presence of ten percent of the members in person shall constitute a quorum at any meeting thereof. The members present and entitled to vote at any meeting, although less than a quorum, may adjourn the meeting from time to time. A majority vote of the members present and entitled to vote at any meeting at which a quorum is present shall be sufficient to transact any business. When any meeting of the members is adjourned to another time and place, notice of the adjourned meeting need not be given other than by announcement at the meeting at which adjournment is taken.

ARTICLE 4

Directors

SECTION 4.1 <u>Number and method of election</u>. The Board of Directors of this corporation shall consist of a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of ten (10) persons, who shall be elected by the membership of the club at the annual meeting. The members of the Board of Directors of this corporation shall serve for the times indicated at the time of their designation. Thereafter, directors of this corporation shall be elected by the voting members at each meeting.

SECTION 4.2 <u>Terms.</u> Except as otherwise provided in Section 4.1, each director of this corporation shall be elected to serve for a term of two (2) years. The members of the Board of Directors shall be divided into two classes, equal in number, so that the terms of office of one half (1/2) of the members of the Board of Directors shall expire each year. A director shall hold office for the term for which he or she was elected and until the end of the meeting at which his or her successor has been elected and until such successor has qualified, or until the director's prior death, resignation or removal. Any director may at any time be removed with or without cause by the members. Any vacancy occurring because of the death, resignation or removal of a director shall be filled by the Board of Directors for the unexpired term of such director.

SECTION 4.3 <u>Honorary directors</u>. The Board of Directors may, from time to time, elect one or more honorary directors of this corporation who shall be advisory members of the Board of Directors of this corporation. Any such election shall be for such term and based on such criteria as the Board of Directors from time to time deems appropriate. All honorary directors shall be non-voting directors of this corporation.

ARTICLE S

Meetings of the Board of Directors

SECTION 5.1 <u>Annual meeting</u>. The annual meeting of the Board of Directors for the purpose of electing officers and transacting such other business as may properly come before the meeting shall be held immediately following the annual meeting of the members of this corporation at the time and place, within or without the State of Minnesota, designated from time to time by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 5.2 Other meetings. Other meetings of the Board of Directors may be held at such time and place as are announced at a previous meeting of the Board of Directors. Meetings of the Board of Directors may also be called at any time (a) by the President, (b) by the Board of Directors, or (c) upon the written request of three or more members of the Board of Directors. Anyone entitled to call a meeting of the Board of Directors may make a written request to the Secretary to call the meeting, and the Secretary shall give notice of the meeting, setting forth the time, place and purpose thereof, to be held between five and thirty days after receiving the request. If the Secretary fails to give notice of the meeting within seven days from the day on which the request was made, the person or persons who requested the meeting may

fix the time and place of the meeting and give notice in the manner hereinafter provided.

SECTION 5.3 <u>Notice of meetings</u>. Written notice of each meeting of the Board of Directors for which written notice is required, and of each annual meeting, stating the time, place and purpose thereof shall be e-mailed or posted on the WSHS district webpage not less than five nor more than thirty days before the meeting, excluding the day of the meeting.

SECTION 5.4 Quorum and voting. The presence of a majority of the members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum at any meeting thereof, but the directors present at any meeting, although less than a quorum, may adjourn the meeting from time to time, At all meetings of the Board of Directors, each director shall be entitled to cast one vote on any question coming before the meeting. A majority vote of the directors present at any meeting, if there be a quorum, shall be sufficient to transact any business, unless a greater number of votes is required by law or these Bylaws. A director shall not appoint a proxy for himself or herself or vote by proxy at a meeting of the Board of Directors. A director who is present at a meeting of the Board of Directors when an action is taken is presumed to have assented to the action unless the director votes against the action or is prohibited from voting on the action.

SECTION 5.5 <u>Adjourned meetings</u>. When a meeting of the Board of Directors is adjourned to another time or place, notice of the adjourned meeting need not be given other than by announcement at the meeting at which adjournment is taken.

SECTION 5.6 <u>Written action</u>. Any action that could be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken by written action signed by all of the directors.

SECTION 5.7 <u>Director conflicts of interest.</u> This corporation shall not enter into any contract or transaction with (a) one or more of its directors, (b) a director of a related organization (within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes, section 317A.011, subd. 18), or (c) an organization in or of which a director is a director, officer or legal representative or has a material financial interest; unless the material facts as to the contract or transaction and as to the director's interest are fully disclosed or known to the Board of Directors, and the Board of Directors authorizes, approves, or ratifies the contract or transaction in good faith by the

affirmative vote of a majority of the directors (without counting the interested director), at a meeting at which there is a quorum without counting the interested director. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Section 5.7 shall not invalidate any contract or transaction to which this corporation is a party.

ARTICLE 6

Officers

SECTION 6.1 <u>Tenure of office</u>. The officers of this corporation shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer and such other officers as the Board of Directors may from time to time designate. Officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors to serve for terms of one year and until their respective successors are chosen and have qualified. Any officer may at any time be removed by the Board of Directors with or without cause.

SECTION 6.2 <u>President</u>. The President shall be the chief executive officer of this corporation. He or she shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors. He or she shall be responsible for the general supervision, direction and management of the affairs of this corporation. He or she may execute on behalf of this corporation all contracts, deeds, conveyances and other instruments in writing which may be required or authorized by the Board of Directors for the proper and necessary transaction of the business of this corporation.

SECTION 6.3 <u>Vice President</u>. The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in case of the latter's absence or disability. The execution by the Vice President on behalf of this corporation of any instrument shall have the same force and effect as if it were executed on behalf of this corporation by the President.

SECTION 6.4 <u>Secretary</u>. The Secretary shall keep accurate minutes of all meetings and shall be custodian of the records, documents and papers of this corporation. He or she shall provide for the keeping of proper records of all transactions of this corporation. He or she shall have and may exercise any and all other powers and duties pertaining by law, regulation or practice to the office of Secretary, or imposed by these Bylaws. He or she shall also perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her from time to time by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 6.5 Assistant Secretary. The Board of Directors in its discretion may

elect an Assistant Secretary, who shall perform the duties and assume the responsibilities of the Secretary as above set forth under the general direction of the Secretary or President.

SECTION 6.6 <u>Treasurer</u>. The Treasurer shall be responsible for maintaining accurate financial records for this corporation and safeguarding the assets of this corporation. He or she shall present a report of this corporation's financial transactions and status to the Board of Directors at its annual meeting, and shall from time to time make such other reports to the Board of Directors as it may require. The Treasurer shall perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her from time to time by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 6.7 <u>Assistant Treasurer</u>. The Board of Directors in its discretion may elect an Assistant Treasurer who shall perform the duties and assume the responsibilities of the Treasurer as above set forth under the general direction of the Treasurer or President.

SECTION 6.8 <u>Additional powers</u>. Any officer of this corporation, in addition to the powers conferred upon him or her by these Bylaws, shall have such powers and perform such additional duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 7

Committees

SECTION 7.1 <u>Authority</u>. The Board of Directors may act by and through such committees as may be specified in resolutions adopted by a majority of the members of the Board of Directors. Each such committee shall have such duties and responsibilities as are granted to it from time to time by the Board of Directors. Each such committee shall at all times be subject to the control and direction of the Board of Directors. Committee members, other than members of the Executive Committee, need not be directors.

SECTION 7.2 Executive Committee. The four officers serve as the members of the Executive Committee. Except for the power to amend the Articles of Incorporation and bylaws, the Executive Committee shall have all the powers and authority of the board of directors in the intervals between meetings of the board of directors, and is subject to the direction and control of the full board.

SECTION 7.3 <u>Meetings and voting</u>. Meetings of each committee may be held at such time and place as are announced at a previous meeting of the committee. Meetings of any

committee may also be called at any time by the chairperson of the committee or by the President, on at least five days' notice by mail, e-mail, or two days oral notice by telephone or in person.

ARTICLE 8

Indemnification

To the full extent permitted by any applicable law, this corporation shall indemnify each person made or threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed civil, criminal, administrative, arbitration, or investigative proceeding, including a proceeding, by or in the right of this corporation, by reason of the former or present capacity of the person as --

- (a) a director, officer, employee or member of a committee of this corporation or,
- (b) a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee or agent of another organization or employee benefit plan, who while a director, officer or employee of this corporation, is or was serving the other corporation at the request of this corporation or whose duties as a director, officer or employee of this corporation involve or involved such service to the other corporation,

against judgments, penalties, fines (including, without limitation, excise taxes assessed against the person with respect to an employee benefit plan), settlements, and reasonable attorneys' fees and disbursements, incurred by the person in connection with the proceeding.

Indemnification provided by this section shall continue as to a person who has

ceased to be a director, officer, employee or committee member, shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors and administrators of such person and shall apply whether or not the claim against such person arises out of matters occurring before the adoption of this section. Any indemnification realized other than under this section shall apply as a credit against any indemnification provided by this section.

This corporation may, to the frill extent permitted by applicable law from time to time in effect, purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a director, officer, employee or a member of a committee of this corporation against any liability asserted against such person and incurred by such person in any such capacity.

ARTICLE 9

Miscellaneous

SECTION 9.1 <u>Fiscal year</u>. Unless otherwise fixed by the Board of Directors, the fiscal year of this corporation shall begin on April 1 and end on the succeeding March 31.

SECTION 9.2 Corporate seal. This corporation shall have no seal.

SECTION 9.3 <u>Electronic communications</u>. A member, director or committee member may participate in a meeting by any means of communication through which such person, other persons so participating, and all persons physically present at the meeting may simultaneously hear each other during the meeting. Participation in a meeting by that means constitutes presence in person at the meeting. A conference among members, directors, or committee members by any means of communication through which such persons may simultaneously hear each other during the conference is a meeting of the members, Board of Directors or committee, as the case may be, if the same notice is given of the conference as would be required for a meeting, and if the number of persons participating in the conference would be sufficient to constitute a quorum at a meeting. Participation in a meeting by that means constitutes presence in person at the meeting.

SECTION 9.4 <u>Amendments</u>. Both the Board of Directors and the members shall have the power to amend these Bylaws. The power of the Board of Directors shall be subject to the power of the members. The Board of Directors may amend the Bylaws by adopting a resolution setting forth the amendment. The Board of Directors may not adopt, amend, or repeal a bylaw fixing a quorum for meetings of members, prescribing procedures for removing directors or filling vacancies in the Board of Directors, or fixing the number of directors or their

classifications, qualifications, or terms of office. An amendment for adoption by the members must be proposed by at least five (5) of the members. The membership may amend the Bylaws by adopting a resolution setting forth the amendment.

SECTION 9.5 <u>Authority to borrow, encumber assets.</u> No director, officer, agent or employee of this corporation shall have any power or authority to borrow money on its behalf, to pledge its credit or to mortgage or pledge its real or personal property except within the scope and to the extent of the authority delegated by resolutions adopted from time to time by the board of Director. Authority may be given by the Board of Directors for any of the above purposes and may be general or limited to specific instances.

SECTION 9.6 <u>Deposit of funds</u>. All funds of this corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of this corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Directors may approve or designate, and all such funds shall be withdrawn only in the manner or manners authorized by the Board of Directors from time to time.

These Bylaws are approved by the members of the Board of Directors as designated in the Articles of Incorporation.
