The Head Start program provides a range of social services to low-income children and their familes including services such as medical, dental and behavioral screening services and treatments, educational and training opportunites for parents, life skills couseling and training, educational curriculums for children while attending full day and part day sessions, life skills training for children, field trip opportunities to broaden childrens exposure, referrals to other EOF programs for other types of direct assistance such as utilities and food assistance. The EOF Head Start Program served 810 children and families directly in its program in Wyandotte County, KS, and indirectly served 68 children and their families through a delegate Head Start Program in Bonner Springs, KS operated by the Bonner Springs USD204.
