

For several years the Fayette County Board of Education, the controlling body for Oak Hill High School, has discussed the likelihood of merging two or more of the county's high schools into a single institution, including Oak Hill High School. Such a merger, should it occur, could result in a change of name for Oak Hill High School and could also result in the new school being located outside the city limits of Oak Hill, West Virginia. Our current charter lists only Oak Hill High School graduates as eligible for the association's scholarship awards. Therefore, the Board of Directors of the Oak Hill High School Alumni Association, Inc. decided that our governing charter should be changed to reflect the possibility of a successor school and the relationship the alumni association would have with such a school.

In addition, the charter was changed to insure that should a dissolution of the organization ever occur, all assets remaining after full settlement of any liabilities would continue to be used for scholarship awards. The remaining assets will be given to the Beckley Area Foundation, a 501 c (3) organization. Earnings from these assets will be used to continue the scholarship program.

The charter changes submitted for approval by the West Virginia Secretary of State are listed below; including the original wording of the charter and the new wording.

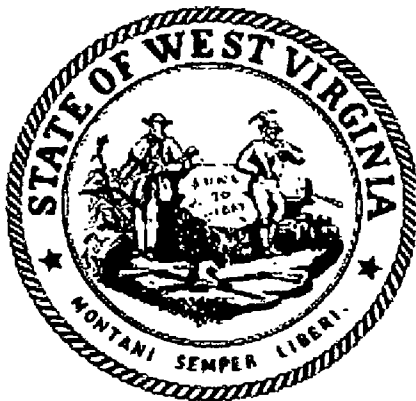
