During our first fiscal year we were able to recruit over 23 partner agencies helping us create a support group so to streamline access to services for both clients and professionals alike. The project also was able to host a number of successful and well attended workshops for professionals as well as for the overall community seminars including "Finding Services for Clients Who Require On-Going Assistance," "Denton County Housing Resources for People with Limited Incomes," and a five piece series supporting Parents with Children with Disabilities. including grants of \$ 24000. Revenue \$ 13860. Expenses \$ 41251.

Funding decisions are based on recognized existing and emerging needs
in Denton County. Five teams of community volunteers review partner
agency programming, outcomes and financials to determine the most
effective use of funds.

Funding for this process comes from UWDC's annual fundraising campaign which is conducted with the help of hundreds of local companies and volunteers. The campaign includes workplace and individual solicitation and corporate donations and sponsorships. Funded partner agencies participate in this process by providing outcome information and numbers served, providing speakers for presentations, and conducting internal fundraising campaigns within their offices. UWDC also provides donors the opportunity to designate their donations to local agencies.

Local agencies must annually verify compliance with provisions of the USA Patriot Act and verify they are an agency in good standing as an IRS Code Section 501(c)3 nonprofit organization.

During 2009-2010 funding year, UWDC was able to distribute a total of \$1,475,125 to our 25 partner agencies.

Through these partnerships, UWDC partner agencies were able to assist more than 100,000 individuals and families in Denton County in 2009.

Credit, and offering choices of how to invest their refunds to benefit

the financial health of their families. VITA (Volunteer Income Tax

Assistance) sites are staffed by IRS certified volunteers who are

trained specifically to offer tax preparation and financial counseling

in a variety of areas.

In 2007, the IRS estimates that over \$16 million in tax credits were unclaimed by Denton County residents who qualified for them. To combat this and get money back into resident's wallets the UWDC offered 16 free tax preparation sessions in 2008. In turn, VITA participants received a total of over \$60,000 in Earn Income Tax Credits and \$181,421 in Federal refunds issued.

In 2008 the UWDC VITA program was able to provide 20 free tax

preparation dates, at 3 different sites, over a period of two and half

months. The accessibility of this program is in strong part because of

the overall increase of volunteers, which doubled since the previous

prepared and submitted 230 tax forms, an 8% increase from 2007.

The IRS estimates that the average out-of-pocket cost incurred by taxpayers to prepare and submit their returns is \$209 per return.
