Proposals are generally accepted three times a year and will be considered at subsequent Board Meetings generally scheduled in January, May and September after it is verified that all of the required information has been provided. Proposals should be received by the specific due dates which are generally at least 45 days prior to the scheduled meetings.
- d. Principally to respond to the needs of Orange and Osceola County, Florida organizations tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation does NOT make grants:
 - to individuals or private foundations
 - to social, religious, fraternal or veterans groups that primarily benefit their own members or adherents
 - to retire accumulated debt
 - for legislative lobbying or other political purposes
