Occasionally, they are used in classes to show them to students and talk about their characteristics and significance. Three replical statues were purchased by the University and are placed throughout the campus in an effort to help the campus appear as it may have looked back when the mansion was originally built. Additionally, the University purchased several pieces of art work that are placed in the Gordon Inman Building. They were bought to enhance the appearance of the interior since the building would be used for various gatherings by the President and Senior Leadership. A majority of the value of the collection lies in the value of the scrolls. (total value of the collection on the books equals \$217,050 and the value of the scrolls on the books is \$162,500.)
