Part I, Line 7 Charity Care, Unreimbursed Medicaid and Subsidized Health Services are converted to cost using the cost to charge ratio derived from the Hospital's cost allocation system. The cost allocation system addresses all patient segments. The costs are estimated by allocating departmental costs based on direct costs less any other operating revenue then an allocation of benefits, depreciation and other overhead costs. Community health improvement services, health professions education and cash and in-kind contributions is derived from the CBISA program.

Part I, Line 7g Subsidized health services includes \$26,686,080 of costs attributable to a physician clinic

Part I, Line 7f The amount of bad debt expense removed from the denominator of the calculations was \$7,393,637

Part III, Line 4 Bad debt expense is calculated at cost using a cost of charge ratio derived from the organization's cost allocation system Bad debt expense is reported net of discounts and contractual allowances. A payment on an account previously written off reduces bad debt expense in the current year Financial statement footnote. Patient receivables are uncollateralized patient and third-party payor obligations. The Organization charges interest at 10 percent per annum on past due accounts after 90 days. Payments of patient receivables are allocated to the specific claims identified on the remittance advice or, if unspecified, are applied to the earliest unpaid claim. The carrying amount of patient receivables is reduced by a valuation allowance that reflects management's best estimate of amounts that will not be collected from patients and third-party payors. Management reviews patient receivables by payor class and applies percentages to determine estimated amounts that will not be collected from third parties under contractual agreements and amounts that will not be collected from patients due to bad debts. Management considers historical write off and recovery information in determining the estimated bad debt provision.

Part III, Line 8 These expenses represent an overall shortfall of the direct Medicare patient population. The costs themselves are therefore a community benefit as the community would not receive these services if we did not provide them. Medicare allowable costs of care are based on the Medicare cost report. The Medicare cost report is completed based on the rules and regulations set forth by CMS.

Part III, Line 9b St Peter's Hospital recognizes its responsibility to render necessary health care services to all persons in need of such care, regardless of race, creed, color or economic circumstances. St Peter's Hospital recognizes that payment for services rendered is due and payable at the time of service. The hospital accepts insurance assignments and some other approved arrangements for delayed payment. Financial assistance is available for all qualified patients. Patients not covered by insurance or unable to pay in full for services rendered must contact the appropriate Patient Account Representative who will assist the patient and/or family in determining if he/she qualifies for patient assistance.

Part V The organization also has the following types of facilities other than those required to be licensed as healthcare facilities in the state of Montana 5 clinics providing the following services- The Broadway location including Family Practice, Ears/Nose/Throat, Internal Medicine, Urology, Rheumotology, Lab, Xray, Pharmacy and Infusion Services - Maria Dean location- Ears/Nose/Throat and Audiology - Maria Dean location for Gastro Services - Maria Dean location for Cardiology Services - North Montana Avenue location included Family Practice, Internal Medicine, X-Ray and Lab Services - Cancer Treatment Center included Medical Oncology and Radiation Therapy Physicians

Part VI, Line 3 St Peter's Hospital posts its charity care policy on its web site as well as (1) at the Admitting Desk, Emergency Room and Cashier areas in which eligible patients are likely to be present, (2) we offer a summary of our policy and application to self pay patients with contact information to patients as part of the intake process, (3) provide a copy of financial assistance contact information to patients with discharge materials, (4) Financial counselors discuss with patients expecting to owe more than \$500 the availability of patient assistance and various government benefits, such as Medicaid or state programs, and assists the patient with qualification for such programs, where applicable

Part VI, Line 5 St Peter's Hospital made \$79,614 of cash and in-kind donations to a variety of organizations within the community. This includes but is not limited to Montana Chamber Foundation, Helena High School Boys Basketball for a new athletic field scoreboard, CR Anderson Middle School for its honor student program, Angel Fund to purchase clothing and school supplies for youth, Military Museum, Carroll College Athletics with emergency services at events, Carroll College Nursing Department with medical supplies needed for learning labs, Exploration Works with medical supplies needed for student science experiments, United Way to assist low-income and homeless residents with basic needs, Spirit of Service Campaign by providing supplies and volunteers to help elderly residents and others with special needs improve their homes and yards, Kay McKenna Youth Foundation to provide safe summer youth activities, Archie Bray Foundation, Downtown Helena and Big Brothers and Sisters. The donations were made to assist these Community Sponsors in their various programs.

Part VI, Line 6 St Peter's Hospital is the sole acute care provider in the primary service area made up of Lewis & Clark County and the northern portion of Jefferson County. There is a population of approximately 68,000. Out-migration is generally limited to tertiary services not available at St. Peter's Hospital including cardiac surgery and neo-natal care. St. Peter's Hospital provides care to all patients regardless of their ability to pay. St. Peter's Hospital maintains charges as one of the lowest Hospitals within the State depending on the services being provided. St. Peter's Hospital sponsors several wellness screenings, health fairs and educational lectures, classes, and events throughout the year to promote better living, nutrition and good health. Continuing education is also provided to the members of the medical community on an on-going basis. In addition, St. Peter's Hospital had 14,037 volunteer hours from the community assisting in a variety of roles within the organization.
