Idaho Elks Rehab Hospital has financial counselors on staff to assist patients in Medicaid, Medicare, and other charity assistance programs. This assures that all patients have access to quality health care services without discrimination and the ability to pay

Part VI, Line 4 Idaho Elks Rehabilitation Hospital has provided over 63 years of Inpatient and Outpatient rehabilitation services to people in southwest Idaho and surrounding area with a physical disability that can benefit from rehabilitation services. IERH consists of 1 Hospital, 4 Hearing and Balance Centers. In addition the hospital provides rehabilitation services at 2 Wound Centers and over 20 Outpatient therapy clinics that are jointly owned through a Partnership with St. Lukes Regional Medical Center, LTD. The primary service region of ADA and Canyon counties consists of a population of approximately 571,000. The average income for Ada and Canyon county is \$57,159 and \$43,976 respectively, and the percent of the population that fall below the federal poverty guidelines is 7.1% and 14.9% respectively. IERH is committed to serving rehabilitation patients regardless of their ability to pay. Approximately 5.2% of FY 2010. Inpatient Admissions were Medicaid recipients and 7.5% were covered by Medicare. 14.5% of all services were provided to Medicaid recipients.
