Estimated provisions for doubtful accounts are recorded to the extent is it probable a portion or all of a particular account will not be
collected. The hospital determines if patient accounts receivable are past due based on the date the service was performed and the
hospital does not charge interest on past due amounts. In evaluating the collectibility of accounts receivable, the company considers a
number of factors, including the age of the accounts, changes in collection patterns, the composition of patient accounts by payor type, the
status of ongoing disputes with third party payors and general industry conditions

Part III, Line 8 the entire amount of "medicare shortfall" should be considered community benefit because medicare patients respresent a significant portion of the hospitals business, approximately 38%. The elderly constitute a recognized charitable class and many of the medicare beneficiaries are poor and would have qualified for the hospital's charity care program. This is especially true when you consider the demographics of this area where the poverty rate is 21% overall. The shortfall was computed by obtaining cost and reimbursement information from the FY2010 medicare cost report.

Part III, Line 9b When an account is final billed and identified as self pay, a letter is sent to the patient requesting either payment or the patient contact the hospital to discuss financial assistance. Payment plans worked out and indigent fund applications can be obtained. On self pay accounts under \$1000 no calls are made to the patient and collection efforts are the same for all accounts unless the patient is making payments or had indicated that they will apply for financial assistance on self pay accounts \$1000-\$5000 the patient will be contacted at least 3 times by telephone to encourage them to discuss their bill and apply for assistance. Patients agreeing to apply for the indigent fund will be given applications and assisted in completing if necessary on accounts under \$2000, incomplete applications will not be accepted. On accounts over \$2000, we will accept all applications and call the patient weekly for 3 weeks to obtain the missing information after 3 weeks, we will mail the application to the patient explaining that we were unable to process and to bring the application back to us when it is complete when patients apply but fail to qualify for the indigent fund we will still work with them to give them charity care under the hospitals guidelines on self pay accounts over \$5000 the patient will be called as soon as the account is 'identified'. The patient will also be called prior to each additional collection letter being sent. After all appropriate collection letters have been sent and telephone calls have been made and the patient has not made an attempt to make suitable arrangements, the account will be referred to an outside collection agency.

Part VI, Line 4 Holy cross hospital exists in a community where american indian, hispanic and anglo cultures with diverse senses of family, time, work and environment co-exist. These cultural threads have created a rich and complex local heritage. To the east is the highest mountain in the state (Wheeler Peak at 13,630 feet) and to the west, a desert mesa where water is not easily accessible and many people live without indoor plumbing. There is a deep hope and spirituality constrasted by deep despair and disenfranchisement, we have the strengths of extended families, small town social networks, and expansive wilderness, yet have some of the harshest social and economic conditions in our country. The median home price is \$273,000 and the poverty rate is 21% which is roughly 120% the NM rate and nearly 200% the US rate. The median income is \$25,883 in Penasco (a village we serve) and is \$16,875 in Picuris Pueblo compared to \$50,046 nationally. The proportion of taos country children in impoverished or low-income families remains among the highest in the country, with more than 25% of all children in poverty, 43% near poverty, and more than half low-income. Unemployment is 13%, and less than 10% of employers offer health insurance benefits. The region contains two American indian pueblos - taos and picuris. Our service area encompasses 23,000 miles and 40,000 people, 55% of whom are hispanic, 37% white and 7.4% native American (US Census Bureau 2008).

Part VI, Line 6 Taos Health systems, locally known as holy cross hospital (HCH) services four rural and frontier counties in northern new mexico WE are a local, independent, non-profit organization with Holy Cross Hospital (HCH) as its regional hub HCH has always been community-focused. From the day it opened until today, the drive behind the hospital's prosperity, and very existence, has come from the local residents. Throughout its 74 year history, it has been able to provide care only because of the dedication and hard work of our community. It is this certainty which inspires our mission, to provide preventative, curative, and supportive healthcare services while maintaining high quality standards and utilizing innovative, educational, and cost-effective approaches for all members of the culturallydiverse taos community and surrounding areas as a non-profit, HCH has a local governing board that includes physicians and community members, with equal representation from the outlying villages of our region. In 1985, the board of directors turned the hospitals financial situation around from near-foreclosure, in 1991, local voters approved a 5% tax to finance a new medical complex, which opened in 1994 This 49 bed medical complex is where HCH is currently housed. In 2006, NM governor Bill Richardson awarded \$1.1 million to build a pediatric clinic, which opened in 2010, and HCH is planning for its next expansion. We employ primary care providers, pediatricians, surgeons, the county's only ob/gyns, and we operate a rehabilitation and physcial therapy center. These services have grown as community needs have been identified. Local community members, alongside hospital administrators, have developed sustainable business models for continued provision of these services. Our community service programs target populations from prenatal care to high school student outreach to support for elders with chronic diseases. They address smoking, chronic disease support, healthy parenting, and other topics In all programs, hch's approach focuses on understanding how families work together and can be supported together, consistent with our community's hispanic and american indian traditions
