DURING THE TAX YEAR, THE ASSOCIATION FILED SUIT ALONG WITH TWO REDEVELOPMENT AGENCIES AGAINST THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO INVALIDATE ABX4-26. CRA BELIEVES ABX4- 26 IS UNCONSTITUTIONAL BECAUSE THE UNQUESTIONED PURPOSE OF THIS BUDGET BILL IS TO HELP BALANCE THE STATE'S BUDGET, NOT TO FURTHER THE PURPOSE OF REDEVELOPMENT. THE CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENT IS THAT TAX INCREMENT BE SPENT TO REPAY INDEBTEDNESS INCURRED TO FINANCE THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT. ABX4-26'S REDIRECTION OF TAX INCREMENT TO SERAF FAILS THE CONSTITUTIONAL REQUIREMENT BECAUSE THE REVENUES DIVERTED ARE NOT RELATED OR PROPORTIONAL TO THE COST OF ANY DIRECT BENEFIT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.
