For the first time the Council offered intensive "Breaking into Business" training programs with consultants from the Arts Extension Service in Massachusetts, to help artists develop marketing and business plans. After completing the workshop training, participants are eligible to apply to the Vermont Arts Council for special grant funding on a competitive basis to implement some aspect of their business or marketing plan.

The "Art of Action" project entered into the second phase, involving touring the artwork of the ten artists commissioned to create works for the project. What has not been done in the past is to involve communities in hosting the exhibits and planning events to involve the public in discussions about the themes addressed on the future of Vermont. The works were exhibited in traditional gallery spaces, but also in non-traditional venues chosen by the communities to reach and involve community members that do not always go into galleries.
