of Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars, if he survives the DONOR.

B. The TRUSTEE shall sell all of the remaining personal tangible property and add the proceeds to the Trust Estate and shall administer the remaining principal and undistributed income of the DONOR'S Trust, whether real, personal or mixed and wherever situated, inclusive of lapsed gifts, if any, as follows:

- 1. One half of said income shall be distributed, at least annually in equal shares to Vermont Academy, Saxtons River, Vermont and Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children and Burns Institute Boston Unit. If either or both of these organizations ceases to be an organization described in Internal Revenue Code Section 170 (c) (2) (B), then the income which would have been distributed to such organizations shall be distributed pursuant to subparagraph B.2. of this ARTICLE III.
- 2. The balance of said income shall be distributed at least annually to such exempt organizations as are described in Internal Revenue Code, Section 170 (c) (2) (B). The TRUSTEE may distribute said income to as few or as many of such organizations and in such proportions as he, in his sole discretion, shall deem appropriate or advisable.
- C. The DONOR has intentionally failed to provide for his sister, MARION L. HARVEY, not from any lack of love or affection, but because she is well possessed of worldly goods.

If the Trust Estate shall at any time fail for want of a beneficiary or beneficiaries, then said Trust Estate shall terminate and the TRUSTEE shall distribute the remaining principal and accumulated net income of the trust to the then living heirs of the DONOR, said heirs and the
