The University utilized said proceeds solely for capital expenditure purposes. Specifically, the financing assisted in the renovation of three academic facilities. The major portion of the debt proceeds went into the interior renovation of the Antone Center for the Arts. Also, smaller portions were used to help with the exterior restoration of McAuley Hall and Angelus Hall. All three facilities do not have any private business use. Lastly, all proceeds were expended within 15 months of the date of issue. All other tax exempt financing presently outstanding were all entered into prior to Dec 31, 2002 and are fixed rate debt issued through RIHEBC.
