Mission

The mission of Queens Council on the Arts is to foster and develop the arts in Queens County and to support arts organizations and individual artists in presenting their cultural diversity for the benefit of the community.

Programs and Services

Grant Programs

QCA grants funds to further sustain the arts and cultural communities of Queens.

- Queens Community Arts Fund regrants funds provided by government, foundations, and JPMorgan Chase to support Queens based individual artists and nonprofit organizations.
- Arts in the Schools Grant Program supports arts education partnerships in Queens schools.
- Urban Artists Initiative NYC provides information and grants to individual artists of African, Asian, Native American and Latin descent.

Professional Services

QCA offers interactive 6-8 workshops annually designed to promote artistic and professional growth. Topics range from online marketing to career planning to obtaining non-profit status. Other services offered include:

 (QUILL), Queens Arts Connection and the Queens Art Express Boot Camps and Mixers.
- QCA partners with the Queens Theatre in the Park and the NYS Parks to present Live at the Gantries, a
 12 week summer outdoor concert series of Queens-based artists at Gantry State Park in Long Island
 City.

Arts Education Programs

QCA supports arts education that develops the next generation of creative citizens.

- High School to Art School provides free portfolio development, studio classes, critical studies discussion, internships, and college advisement for talented Queens high school students.
- Arts in the Schools Grant Program (see Grant Programs).
- Queens Arts in Education Roundtable provides opportunities to share valuable information about arts education.
