IN FURTHERANCE OF ITS EDUCATIONAL MISSION TO PROMOTE THE ACQUISITION OF

KNOWLEDGE THROUGH EXPLORATION AND PRESERVE THE "INSTINCT TO EXPLORE", THE ORGANIZATION MAKES ITS COLLECTIONS AVAILABLE FOR USE BY A WIDE RANGE OF PEOPLE IN A VARIETY OF FIELDS INCLUDING BIOGRAPHERS, GENEALOGISTS, FILMMAKERS, CURATORS, WRITERS, JOURNALISTS, PHOTO RESEARCHERS, INDEPENDENT ENTHUSIASTS, STAFF MEMBERS, AND STUDENTS.
