SOLICITATION OF INDIVIDUAL AND TRUST DONATIONS ALONG WITH ESTATE BEQUETHS ARE THE CURRENT FOCUS OF THE FOUNDATION. THE FOUNDATION HAS SET A GOAL OF DISBURSING 5 % OF ANNUAL NET WORTH TO QUALIFIED ORGANIZATIONS.
