FY 2010 Cinereach LTD Area Descriptions

Grants

During FY 2010 Cinereach Ltd made 30 grants totaling \$1,125,175 to 18 film projects and organizations in furtherance of Cinereach's primary exempt purpose. The Grants & Awards program uses a biannual open call process to discover works-in-progress at all stages of production, from all over the world. These projects are led by first-time emerging or experienced filmmakers with a clear and compelling vision. When available, discretionary grants are awarded in between grant cycles. Projects selected to receive grants towards completion can also rely on the Cinereach staff for beneficial guidance and introductions within the industry, as well as a public vote of confidence that can lead to other funders offering support.

Productions

During FY 2010 Cinereach Ltd developed, financed and produced the fiction feature project "Beasts of the Southern Wild" as well as financed the fiction project "Forgiveness of Blood" in furtherance of Cinereach's primary exempt purpose. Furthermore, Cinereach supported the development stage of the feature documentary entitled "The Bully Project." Cinereach Productions operates as a rare not-for-profit financier of independent feature films, leveraging significant support towards projects with small budgets and important voices that might otherwise remain under the industry's radar.

Special Projects

During FY 2010 Cinereach Ltd held the following special projects and events in furtherance of their primary exempt purpose

- -Through the Reach Film Fellowship Program, four filmmakers per year are selected to receive a \$5,000 grant towards their short film. Cinereach offers production support, seven months of mentorship, career advising and industry exposure as they progress through the entire production and post-production process and prepare for submissions to festivals and distributors. The third annual "Reach Out" event, which was held April 19th 2010, commenced with a screening that showcased the work of the four Reach Film Fellows. A total of about 200 guests from the film industry and Cinereach's network were invited to attend the premiere of the Fellows' films and a reception to celebrate their achievements and introduce them to the industry.
- -On December 7th, 2009, Cinereach held a screening of the unfinished film "Pushing the Elephant," which was awarded a grant in August 2008. Following this, Cinereach cohosted a holiday outreach event at our offices with two non-profit organizations, also past grant recipients, Rooftop Films and Arts Engine, Inc. The event's goal was to stimulate engagement and dialogue amongst each group's core constituency, effectively deepening and expanding each group's base.
- -This year marked the 4th annual Human Rights Watch Filmmakers' Dinner, a dinner hosted by Cinereach that recognizes up-and-coming filmmakers who are making an impact through their work. This year also marked the 4th annual Cinereach Award, which is a \$5,000 prize honoring a Human Rights Watch International Film Festival film that exemplifies masterful use of craft in conveying a vital message. Cinereach was proud to present the 2010 Cinereach Award to Rebecca Richman Cohen for her film "War Don Don."
