#### **GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

These guidelines are provided to assist those charitable organizations which are considering making application for grants from the DALE E. AND CHERYL E. BARTCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC. There are many worthy charitable causes, but those which fall within the following described guidelines are the causes which the DALE E. AND CHERYL E. BARTCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC., are most inclined to support. The grant committee charged with responsibility for selecting recipients of gifts from the DALE E. AND CHERYL E. BARTCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC., will follow the grant guidelines.

The grant committee shall consider all qualified applications received from organizations that are exempt from taxation under the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America.

The qualified organizations are those which are charitable, religious, and/or educational in nature. No part of any gift shall be used to influence legislation or to carry on propaganda, the sole object and purpose of the charitable foundation being to further the cause of charity, education, and religion.

Decisions regarding grants will be based on the following described considerations, and if DALE E. BARTCH, CHERYL E. BARTCH and KRISTEN L. BARTCH are deceased, then the funds of the Foundation shall be administered as follows:

- A. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be set aside as a segregated fund to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association, to be used as needed for the direct benefit of the clients, and <u>not</u> for administrative costs.
- B. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be set aside as a segregated fund to benefit the United Way of Lake County, Florida to be distributed to the approved agencies determined by the Budget and Allocations Committee to be in the greatest need. This shall be distributed at a rate of \$250,000.00 per year until this segregated fund is exhausted.
- C. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be distributed to the American Cancer Society to be used for direct research costs.

- D. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be distributed to the American Heart Association to be used as deemed necessary but <u>not</u> for administrative costs.
- E. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be set aside as a segregated fund to benefit the Sunrise ARC of Lake County, Florida for the direct benefit of the clients and <u>not</u> for administrative costs. Distributions from this segregated account shall be made as the Directors shall so determine.
- F. Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) shall be distributed to the Lake Sumter Community College for the construction of a building on campus, which will be named after the Bartch family.
- G. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be distributed to the Florida Hospital Diabetes Foundation to be used as deemed necessary but not to be used for administrative costs.
- H. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be distributed to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Lake and Sumter Counties to establish an endowment in the name of Dale E. and Cheryl E. Bartch.
- I. The remainder of the Foundation's assets shall be managed and distributed for the sole benefit of providing post-secondary education scholarships to deserving, needy students. The criteria for defining "deserving" and "needy" shall be determined by the directors of the Foundation.

Provided, however, should KRISTEN L. BARTCH survive DALE E. BARTCH and CHERYL E. BARTCH, then, as the Managing Director of the Foundation, the above set forth Guidelines shall <u>not</u> be mandatory, but shall be used by KRISTEN L. BARTCH as a guide setting forth the charitable inclinations of DALE E. and CHERYL E. BARTCH.

Though the guidelines set forth hereinabove shall be adhered to by the Gift Committee of the Foundation in virtually every choice of recipients of funds, the Gift Committee reserves the right to select deserving donees that fall outside the definition of the guidelines but that demonstrate an unusual need in harmony with the concerns of the DALE E. AND CHERYL E. BARTCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC.

- Financial information for prior 3 years (financial statements; audited or unaudited if unaudited, please explain why)
- Proposed budget for current year for both the project and the organization/institution
- Source(s) of other funding for the project for which funding is requested (if applicable)

#### FOLLOW-UP PROCESS

Proposals will be reviewed upon receipt. Additional information may be requested. Once all required information is received, the proposal will be presented at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Grant Committee.

Once a decision is made by the Committee, the Foundation will communicate the decision to the applicant in writing.
