Devon Rotary 2010 Scholarships

Paul Austin Scholarship

This scholarship is a \$1000 scholarship per year, renewable for four years. It is designated for a student graduating from Jonathan Law who will be attending a 4-year college in the Fall. This scholarship is based on academics, service, need, and high school activities. It is renewable provided that the student maintains a 3.0 college GPA and is enrolled as a full time student.

Frederick De Luca Foundation Scholarship

This \$1,000 scholarship is made possible through a grant from the DeLuca Foundation. It is designated for a graduating senior from Jonathan Law who will be attending a 4-year college in the Fall. Preference is given to Subway employees. This scholarship is based on academics, service, need, and high school activities.

Judge Bernard F. Joy Memorial Scholarship

This is a \$1,000.00 scholarship for any student graduating from a Milford high school or Milford resident graduating from any high school who is continuing his or her education at an accredited post high school institution. This is designated for a student who is interested in legal, paralegal, real estate, social work, social services or other law related fields. It is based on community service and need.

Dodie Ireland Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was established in memory of Gloria "Dodie" Ireland, a past member of the Devon Rotary who was extremely devoted to youth, and especially to the students at Platt Tech. This \$1,000 scholarship has been designated for a graduate of Platt RVTS who will be continuing his or her education at an accredited post-graduate institution.

Duke Scholarship

This scholarship is a \$1,000 award made possible by a donation from the Hassenmayer family. It is for any student graduating from a Milford high school or Milford resident graduating from any high school who is continuing his or her education at an accredited post-graduate institution. It is designated for a student who will be studying animal sciences, pre-veterinary studies, or any related major. It is based on service, need, and academics.

Albert Secondi Memorial Scholarship.
