Together the hospital and its physicians are committed to providing a timely, accurate record for patients to reduce unnecessary testing and reduce costs. In addition to the EMR, the hospital has invested funds to improve technology and to open new centers. Most recently, the hospital opened its second Express. Care in Spring Grove along with a newly renovated Laboratory, Imaging Center and Rehabilitation Center. The Lung and Sleep Center was also opened providing patients with a single location for respiratory therapy and sleep needs. Through our most valuable assets, our volunteers and employees, along with our ongoing commitment to our community. Hanover Hospital has furthered its exempt purpose.
