PDC IS IN THE PROCESS OF UPGRADING ITS CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY. NEW FORMS HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED BY LEGAL COUNSEL THAT WILL ALLOW THE ORGANIZATION TO MORE CLOSELY MONITOR AND ENFORCE COMPLIANCE ON A MORE FORMAL AND ANNUAL BASIS. AS PDC EXPLORES MORE DIRECT SERVICES TO COMMUNITIES IN THE FUTURE, GREATER MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT WILL BE NEEDED. THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE IS CHARGED WITH GOVERNANCE OF THIS FUNCTION.
