


PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Esperanza has enrolled over 2,500 people in its EARN Center job training programs, providing instruction, internships and job search assistance for positions in administration, retail, telemarketing, hospitality, and health care. The program also provides assistance in preparing resumes, interviewing, personal budgeting, time management, self-esteem building, and negotiating skills. The Esperanza CareerLink Center serves an additional 2,500 community residents annually, as a One-Stop-Shop to access job counseling and job training, and provides employers with opportunities to hire capable area residents.

EDUCATION

Esperanza College, a branch campus of Eastern University, is the only Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) in Pennsylvania and the only program of its kind in the country where students study in Spanish, while learning English. Upon earning their associate degrees, students are prepared to transfer to four-year colleges and universities. The two-year college takes students with language challenges and has a graduation rate of over 57% compared with other junior colleges where only 39% of Hispanics earn their associate degrees. Nearly 50% of our alumni continue into four-year colleges.

- The college also offers a CDA program – Child Development Association certificate, for persons working at early childhood centers.
- Esperanza English Institute is Esperanza's primary language education arm. It prepares students to enter the College, is made accessible to graduates of job training program, while also serving the broader Spanish-speaking migrant or client population.

NATIONAL

Esperanza works partially as an intermediary between government agencies and Hispanic faith- and community-based organizations. Together with over 10,000 Hispanic churches and organizations, Esperanza has emerged as a leading voice for Hispanics of faith in the nation. Esperanza has several national initiatives that continue the work of Nueva Esperanza, Inc. on a national scale, serving the needs of the Hispanic community as well as strengthening the work of Hispanic faith-based organizations

- Hispanic Capacity Project:** Esperanza has worked since 2002 to build the capacity of Hispanic serving and Hispanic led agencies throughout the nation. Our experiences with over 420 organizations in over 22 states have shown that many are still nascent, and lack financial resources and expertise. Esperanza acts as an intermediary or technical assistance provider, making available training and grant funds that boost the quality of services delivered around the country.

STRENGTHENING OUR HISPANIC COMMUNITY

- b. **National Housing Counseling and Foreclosure Mitigation** is a national program begun in 2009, working with 13 affiliate organizations, based on site, to build the capacity of affiliate organizations to build housing counseling infrastructure and so, prevent or mitigate foreclosure and provide services, counseling and referral around pre-purchase, credit counseling and financial literacy. These organizations are located in Glendale and Phoenix, Arizona, East Palo Alto, California, Miami Springs, Florida, Nashville, Tennessee, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania. The National program also provides direct service on site with a local branch serving over 700 clients annually.
- c. **Marriages of Hope** is a relationship and marriage building curriculum development initiative where master trainers train other married couples to build a cohort of highly skilled trainers that will build healthy families in communities of faith in New York and Southern California. With a five year Marriage Enhancement grant from Office of Family Assistance within the Administration for Children and Families, Esperanza has trained 366 master trainer couples and 1338 community couples in relationship and marriage enhancement skills for a total of 1704 couples served within the five years of this initiative.
- d. **Health Education:** With HIV/AIDS being one of the leading causes of death in the Latino community, Nueva Esperanza initiated "*Pacto de Esperanza*" in 2003. This program educates clergy about the epidemic, breaking down its taboos and the barriers to accessing treatment and critical social services. Our outreach efforts include providing technical assistance and small grants to Hispanic faith-based organizations with existing HIV/AIDS programs, developing culturally and constituency appropriate literature to inform and educate the Hispanic community about HIV/AIDS, and designing specific educational programs for Hispanic clergy and lay leadership.
- e. **Tesoros de Esperanza (Treasure of Hope) Begins:** Esperanza was awarded funding from the Department of Health and Human Services in 2007 to deliver abstinence education through partner organizations Templo CDC and La Familia Hispana in Orange County, California. In California in 2006, Hispanics under age 19 accounted for 84.6% of total births to teens (citation). The program provides youth ages 12-18 with the self-confidence needed to make healthy choices through classes, youth rallies, and peer mentors.
- f. **Hispanic Capacity Project:** In 2008, Esperanza's capacity building work came full circle as we brought our national experience to bear on Pennsylvania regions with fast-growing Hispanic populations. For the 2010 Fiscal Year, Esperanza partnered with the Department of Health and Human Services and the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development to implement its successful Hispanic Capacity Project in Philadelphia. The program serves Hispanic leaders in Allentown, Bethlehem, Lancaster, Reading and Philadelphia where Hispanics constitute 23.8% of the population.
- g. **Esperanza Capacity Institute:** In 2007, Esperanza launched the first Esperanza Capacity Institute at its offices in Philadelphia. Over 53 Hispanic non-profit leaders from across 12 states attended. Classes were offered in key organizational function area such as leadership, board management, fundraising, grant-writing, and forming partnerships over the course of two days. Attendees heard from a panel of local funders and network with other leaders



IMMIGRATION

Esperanza produced *The Survivor's Guide to Immigration* for immigrants and clergy in June of 2008 with funding from the Carnegie Corporation of New York. The guides provide practical information for how to navigate life in the United States. They are informed by a series of focus group calls with clergy across ten cities in 2008 that demonstrated the impact of changing immigration enforcement policies and social climate upon Hispanic communities of faith.

Background Highlight: Esperanza has fought for comprehensive immigration reform since 2004, conducting visits with Senators and Representatives and making numerous presentations before government agencies. Since then, Esperanza has moved through the first four phases of The Citizenship Project (Proyecto Ciudadanía) of actively equipping clergy to move individuals towards citizenship. In 2009, Esperanza began providing legal services by an accredited immigration lawyer. Esperanza is recognized by the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA). As a BIA recognized organization we service individuals whose family income is less than 250% of the Federal Poverty Level. Services are in four main areas: 1) Family Petitioners, 2) Lawful Permanent Residents Seeking to Naturalize, 3) Immigrants seeking to Adjust Status, and 4) Future-Eligible Immigrants.


