It also considers market comparison reports prepared by an external compensation consultant with significant experience in performing executive and physician compensation assessments for not-for-profit healthcare organizations. The Committee's process is designed to qualify for the rebuttable presumption of reasonableness for those individuals with oare disqualified persons. The peer group for executives generally includes large and complex academic medical centers and health systems. For physicians and scientists, the peer group generally includes academic medical centers. Information from other organizations may also be considered where appropriate for the position. For those individuals with oare not physicians or scientists, their compensation is established according to an administrative compensation plan of The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, which includes consideration of market compensation for similar positions, and that has a potential for incentive compensation based on productivity, performance and other factors for certain positions.
