Glen Arbor Associates has been asked to express its opinion of the fair market value of a minority interest (not exceeding 49%) in the common stock (the "Shares") of Henkels & McCoy, Inc. ("Henkels" or the "Company") as of December 31, 2009 (the "Valuation Date") in connection with gifts and charitable contributions of such shares. The valuation will be used for no purpose other than to support the gift and income tax returns filed with respect to such gifts and contributions.

Glen Arbor Associates ("GAA") is a business valuation firm regularly engaged in the valuation of closely-held businesses and significant interests therein. This report was prepared by the undersigned. The credentials of the undersigned are attached as Appendix I. Neither GAA nor any of its officers or employees has any interest in the Company and all of such persons are independent with respect to the valuation discussed herein. GAA's compensation for services rendered is not contingent on any action or event resulting from our opinion.

This valuation is prepared in conformity with the ethics and standards of the American Society of Appraisers and the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice of the Appraisal Foundation.

#### Definition of Fair Market Value

Fair market value is the price at which the Shares would change hands between a willing buyer and a willing seller when the former is not under any compulsion to buy and the latter is not under any compulsion to sell, and both parties are able, as well as willing, to trade and are well informed about the Company and the market for the Shares.

#### Factors Considered

Our opinion as to the value of the Shares is based on all relevant factors, including the following: (a) the nature of the Company's business; (b) conditions in the economy and the Company's industry; (c) the value of the Company's assets and the financial condition of the Company; (d) the earning capacity of the Company; (e) the history of dividends, the capacity to pay dividends, and the likelihood of dividends in the future; (f) whether or not the Company has goodwill or other intangible value; (g) transactions in the capital stock of the Company; and (h) the value of common stock of corporations (listed on exchanges, NASDAQ or traded over the counter) engaged in similar lines of business as the Company where such stock is traded in a free and open market.

For the purposes of this valuation, we have considered the applicability of marketability discounts to reflect the value of the Shares.

#### Limiting Conditions

In forming our opinion, we have relied on (i) management's oral representations concerning the Company's finances and operations; (ii) audited financial statements prepared by the Company's accountants for the fiscal years ended on or about September 30, 2005 through 2009. In addition, we have previously visited the Company's headquarters in Blue Bell, Pennsylvania.

Compass Capital Partners, Ltd. has previously issued opinions of the fair market value of the Shares as of June 30, 1999, January 1, 2000, January 1, 2001, January 1, 2002, January 1, 2003, January 1, 2004, February 1, 2005, December 31, 2005, and December 31, 2006 ("CCP Prior Opinions"). GAA has previously issued its opinion of the fair market value of the Shares as of December 31, 2007, December 31, 2008, and January 1, 2009 ("GAA Prior Opinions"). We incorporate herein by reference the CCP Prior Opinions and GAA Prior Opinions.

While we considered all of the factors described above, we have not discussed them herein, except to the extent that there has been a material difference between facts existing as of January 1, 2009 (the last valuation date) and as of December 31, 2009 (the current Valuation Date).

#### Financial Review

Exhibits 1 sets forth the Company's historical balance sheet as of the fiscal years ended on or about September 30, 2005 through 2009. Exhibit 2 sets forth the Company's historical income statement for the fiscal years ended on or about September 30, 2005 through 2009.

From a working capital perspective, the Company's working capital has decreased from \$119.2 million in 2005 to \$101.2 million in 2006, increased to \$127.6 million in 2008, and then decreased to \$121.3 million in 2009. Management believes that its working capital level is adequate to fund its operations as now or proposed to be conducted. The Company had \$147.8 million of property at the end of fiscal 2009, up from \$126.8 million at the end of fiscal 2008. The Company carried approximately \$12.4 million of debt at the end of fiscal 2009, down from \$30.6 million at the end of fiscal 2008.

As Exhibit 2 shows, the Company's sales steadily increased from \$709.1 million in 2005 to \$1,195.1 million in 2008 and then decreased to \$1,184.0 million in 2009. Gross profit margin increased from 19.8% in 2005 to 21.9% in 2006, decreased to 20.6% in 2007, increased to 20.9% in 2008, and then decreased to 19.6% in 2009. Operating expenses increased from \$100.7 million in 2005 to \$152.0 million in 2009. EBITDA (earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization) increased from \$54.2 million in 2005 to \$123.1 million in 2008 and then decreased to \$103.6 million in 2009.

We reviewed the Company's earnings growth expectations with Joseph C. Paulits, IV, the Company's Treasurer, and concluded that a 2.0% average annual growth rate at the revenue and EBITDA level is reasonable for the next five years.

#### Valuation Review

We updated the information in our guideline companies' analysis in Exhibits 4, 5 and 6.

We noted that the Company's projected earnings will continue to grow at a slower rate (2%) than is projected for the public guideline companies (2% to 10.5%). Accordingly, we concluded that our earnings capitalization methodology continues to be the

most meaningful methodology to use in valuing the Shares. In Exhibit 8 we calculated an adjusted capitalization rate for the Company's EBITDA. In our judgment, 22.2% is an appropriate capitalization rate by which to capitalize the Company's EBITDA in arriving at its debt free value. Applying that capitalization rate to fiscal 2009 EBITDA and deducting debt generates an indicated fully distributed value of \$42.19 per Share. See Exhibit 7.

Our calculated fully distributed value of \$42.19 per Share represents a marketable minority value. We continue to believe that were there no current prospect of selling the Shares to the Company (see discussion of this issue below) a 40% discount should be applied to freely traded values to reflect the lack of marketability of the Shares. Application of that discount to the calculated fully distributed value per Share of \$42.19 yields an indicated value of \$25.31 per Share. See Exhibit 9.

As discussed at length in the CCP Prior Opinions and GAA Prior Opinions, all of the Company's outstanding shares are subject to a Shareholders' Agreement which was entered into on September 30, 1968 by all of the Company's shareholders and amended January 23, 1974 (the "Agreement"). The Agreement requires that a shareholder offer shares to the Company and other shareholders before selling them. The offer price is specified to be the lowest price at which the shareholder is willing to sell but in no event in excess of the book value of such shares (as determined by the Company's accountants) at the close of the most recent preceding fiscal year. If the Company and the other shareholders decline the offer, the selling shareholder may sell the shares to a third party at a price not less than that which was offered to the Company or the other shareholders. Transferred shares continue to be subject to the Agreement.

The Company has every incentive to buy at book value because the transaction is financially neutral to the other shareholders and creates liquidity for such shareholders that otherwise does not exist. The Company has honored every tender of shares to it in the past 20 years, and its cash position is adequate to permit it to honor future tenders. The Agreement thus fixes the proceeds receivable by any selling shareholder at the most recent year-end book value. At September 27, 2009, book value was \$22.59 per share.

#### Value Conclusion

Because of the terms of the Agreement and the Company's willingness and financial ability to buy shares tendered to it pursuant to the Agreement (i.e., the most recent year-end book value), GAA is of the opinion that the fair market value of the Shares as of the Valuation Date was \$22.59 per Share.
