Under the agreement Dr. Wheeler receives an annual consulting fee and certain discretionary bonus payments at the discretion of the Foundation Board and Dr. Wheeler agrees to lend his expertise to the Foundation in various fundraising initiatives, particularly as it relates to the cultivation and solicitation of collectors and donors. The initial term of the agreement continued through April 30, 2010. On July 1, 2010, the Foundation entered into a revised five year consulting agreement with Dr. Wheeler, the terms of which are largely consistent with the previous agreement, except that Dr. Wheeler will receive an annual retention payment payable at the end of each fiscal period in which he remains in active service at the Museum.

The Audit Committee serves as an independent and objective party to monitor the Foundation's financial and compliance reporting process including oversight of the 990 tax filing as well as its internal control system. The Audit Committee meets with external auditors and Foundation management to review the results of the annual audit and related financial statements and reviews the full 990 tax filing prior to its submission. The 990 is also reviewed by chief legal counsel.

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MONITORING CONFLICTS OF INTEREST	FORM 990, PART VI - SECTION B, LINE 12C	The Audit Committee also serves as the ethics committee for the Foundation, overseeing the whistleblower, records retention, conflicts of interest and confidentiality policies. The Audit Committee Chairman is the independent party to which employees and board members may report any ethics concerns or possible conflicts of interest. The Committee meets at least twice per year and more often as necessary. Potential conflicts of interest are reviewed with the Foundation's Chief Deputy Director and Chief Financial Officer as needed for resolution. An annual acknowledgement process occurs with all board members and staff whereby they formally certify receipt of all governance policies and agreement to comply with them

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PROCESS FOR DETERMINING COMPENSATION	FORM 990, PART VI - SECTION B, LINE 15	The Personnel Committee of the Board of Directors has the primary governing responsibility of overseeing human resource matters and also works in conjunction with the Finance Committee as it relates to any financial impact of decisions taken. The Personnel Committee serves as an independent and objective party to monitor the Foundation's personnel, compensation, stipend and compliance processes as necessary. Their charter outlines specific responsibility for evaluating the performance of the Foundation's Chief employee (the Chief Deputy Director/ and Chief Financial Officer) and setting the senior employee's compensation level based on the results of this evaluation. The Museum Director is a state employee whose compensation is supplemented by the Foundation. The Director also has a consulting agreement with the Foundation under which he receives certain additional compensation upon Board discretion. The Personnel Committee's charter also outlines specific responsibility for evaluating the Museum Director's performance under this agreement and making recommendations to the full board with respect to compensation. To ensure any compensation recommendations are reasonable, the Personnel Committee meets and discusses annually the performance of both the Museum Director and the Foundation's Chief employee based upon specific goals and accomplishments outlined for the year. The Committee reviews the latest American Association of Museum's (AAM) annual salary survey as a basis for comparison of compensation reasonableness. The AAM survey provides benchmark data of US Museums by geographic area, population, and budget size for key museum positions. Final recommendations are submitted to the full board for approval and inclusion in the Foundation's operating budget.
