THE ARBORETUM SERVES A BROAD AUDIENCE WITH 317,939 VISITORS AND 21,881 MEMBERS IN FISCAL 2010. INNOVATIVE NATURAL SCIENCE AND HORTICULTURAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS ARE OFFERED FOR INDIVIDUALS OF ALL AGES. NEARLY 60,000 CHILDREN, ADULTS, TEACHERS, AND FAMILIES PARTICIPATED IN A WIDE VARIETY OF HORTICULTURAL AND NATURAL SCIENCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS. THE ARBORETUM'S HORTICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTER HAS DEVELOPED 155 VARIETIES OF COLD-HARDY FRUIT AND LANDSCAPE PLANTS.
