University of Utah Research Foundation (the "Foundation") respectfully requests that the Internal Revenue Service waive penalties due to the late filing of the Foundation's FYE June 30, 2010 Form 990. As discussed further below, the Foundation believes it was due to reasonable cause and has made good faith efforts to comply with its reporting obligations.

From its creation as a section 501(c)(3) organization until FYE June 30, 2009, the Foundation timely filed its IRS Form 990. In April 2011, the Foundation determined that it was an "affiliate of a governmental unit" pursuant to § 6033(a)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code as a governmental supporting organization. It also believed that it qualified as a nonprivate foundation under Internal Revenue Code section 509(a)(1). As such, the Foundation believed that it no longer was required to file a Form 990. In furtherance of its belief that it was no longer subject to these filing requirements, it filed a request with the IRS in Covington, Kentucky on August 16, 2011 for a determination to be excepted from the annual information returns requirements.

Subsequent to the August 2011 filing, the Foundation became concerned about its ability to satisfy the classification rules of Code section 509(a)(1). Following several conferences with the IRS representative reviewing the ruling request, the Foundation realized that since it would not qualify as a section 509(a)(1) organization, it would withdraw its ruling request and that occurred in July, 2012.

Having concluded that the Foundation is not exempt from the Form 990 filing requirement, the Foundation has worked diligently to complete its FYE June 30, 2010 Form 990 for filing. Going forward, the Foundation will, of course, return to its past practice of timely filing these information returns. Therefore, due to its misunderstanding about its nonprivate foundation status, the Foundation now requests that any late filing penalties be waived since it has demonstrated that the failure was due to reasonable cause.
