The Personnel Committee also reviews and sets the salaries for the senior officers of the College (provost and dean of the college, vice president for administration and planning, vice president for admissions and financial aid, dean of student affairs and vice president for college advancement). The Personnel Committee is provided with comparative data for the president and senior officers relative to similar institutions in mission, enrollment size, finances, etc. The Personnel Committee also receives a report of how faculty salaries and compensation compare at Lycoming College relative to similar institutions. The President approves the salary for all other employees within the parameters set by the Board, the College's salary grades for each position and various compensation surveys. The President receives comparative data for all mid-level and administrative employees relative to the same comparison group that is used by the Personnel Committee. The Director of Human Resources provides comparative data for the administrative assistant and physical laborer positions to the President. Continuing faculty and staff salaries are approved by the President upon the recommendation of the corresponding senior officer and based on the College's evaluation and personnel policies.
