The number of patients who receive services continues to grow since Concordia acquired the facility. Concordia established an in-house therapy department, as opposed to contracting for services as the former owner had done. Multiple patients who have exhausted their financial resources have been subsidized to ensure they may remain with the facility. Concordia employees have also participated in health fairs and other informative services in the surrounding community.
4c	(Code) (Expenses \$ 1,443,321 including grants of \$) (Revenue \$ 1,699,426) The assisted living facility at Concordia of the South Hills is licensed for 48 assisted living units and 12 memory support units. The number of individuals who reside in assisted living continues to increase since Concordia acquired the facility. Under Concordia, the facility now has a full license for assisted living as opposed to the provisional license the former owners had. Multiple patients who have exhausted their financial resources have been subsidized to ensure they may remain with the facility.
