Its medical and scientific research programs include studies that are not commercially sponsored GSH participates in Medicare and Medicaid and other government-sponsored health care programs, and has an active charity care program. Good Samaritan Hospital, and its partner, Bethesda, are acute tiertiary teaching hospitals. With the rest of TriHealth, they form a system of services spa nning from acute care to home care, and babies to seniors. Among other services, Good Sama ritan provides a 24-hour emergency room, four intensive care units for neonates and adults, adult and geriatric inpatient psychiatric care, and an accredited rehabilitation medicin e program. Services are open to all individuals regardless of ability to pay. Good Samarit an Hospital has an open medical staff and a history of training and educating medical resi dents and health care professionals. Its medical and scientific research programs include studies that are not commercially sponsored. Good Samaritan Hospital participates in Medic are and Medicaid and other government-sponsored health care programs, and has an active charity care program. Good Samaritan was granted tax exempt status as a hospital on March 25, 1946. Community service is central to Good Samaritan Hospital's mission Services such a s those described in this report, and others not listed here, promote a healthy community. Programs also seek to reduce the burdens on the government. For example, if Good Samarita in Hospital did not address the root causes of low birth weight and prematurity, the burden to government medical programs such as Medicaid would be even greater. Community Benefit Approach Located in Cincinnati, O.H., Good Samaritan Hospital and the TriHealth system serve Hamilton, Butler, Warren and Clermont counties, as well as persons from Indiana and Kentu cky, Ohio's third largest city, Cincinnati has an estimated population of 333,013. The population within the four O hio counties served by TriHealth is estimated to be 1,613,008 and eleven to twelve percent of this population is uninsured Community health needs, as asse ssed by independent groups such as the Greater Cincinnati United Way, and the Health Found ation of Greater Cincinnati, continue to correspond with the TriHealth community needs ass essment completed in 2004. The significant health needs for the greater Cincinnati area are infant mortality, obesity, depression, hypertension and diabetes. Two major strategies are in place to address infant mortality and diabetes. The remaining community health needs receive the organization's expertise and focus through ongoing hospital and physician practice initiatives. Hamilton County's infant mortality rate of nineteen percent, the highes time Ohio, led Good Samaritan Hospital to create a task force and collaborate with other hospitals and agencies including the Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center Strategies include investigating the root causes of prematurity and low birth weight. Good Samari tan Hospital provides and supports a diversity of programs of prenatal care for at-risk mo thers discussed later in this report. The TriHealth Community Health Initiative for Diabet es, led by the TriHealth physician practices and outpatient clinics with diabetes educators, focuses on the ongoing management of diabetes. The chronic care model focuses on patient education and empowerment. Physician practices track effectiveness in care delivery through measures such as the hemoglobin A1C, a measure of the patient's diabetes selfmanageme nt. Good Samaritan Hospital, as a part of TriHealth, has dedicated staff to assist the community benefit effort including those overseeing the planning, reporting and tracking of community benefit, as well as those providing direct service to the poor and broader community Free and discounted services are provided for

those unable to pay and meeting eligibility criteria. Through the Hospital Care Assurance Program (HCAP), Good Samaritan Hospital serves patients meeting criteria set forth by the Ohio Department of Jobs and Family Services. Good Samaritan Hospital policy is to provide charity care on a sliding scale discounting when the family income is up to 400 percent of the annually established federal poverty guideline. Good Samaritan Hospitals and owned p hysician practices offer an uninsured discount for medically necessary services for those who have no insurance and who do not qualify for other financial assistance options. Good Samaritan Hospital financial counselors assist patients in completing the financial assist ance application which is also available on the website. Brochures about financial assista nce are visible and available in hospital registration and admitting areas. The Good Samar itan Hospital provided \$39.8 million in total community benefit for fiscal year 2010. This includes over \$24 million care in uncompensated care. The amount of benefit for both trad itional charity care and for the unpaid cost of Medicaid is slightly increased from the prior year and reflects the growing number of persons without health insurance. The Medicaid public program reimburses the hospital for services but payments may not always cover the total cost of care and medications. Good Samaritan Hospital fulfills its mission of compassion to the vulnerable members of the community it serves. The Good Samaritan Hospital of Cincinnati, Ohio, as a part of TriHealth, Inc., has dedicated staff to assist the community benefit effort including those overseeing the planning, reporting and tracking of community benefit, as well as those providing direct service to the poor and broader community. In addition, The Good Samaritan Hospital of Cincinnati, O hio assists, through volunteering, the Work Resource Center of Cincinnati which provides skills training for individuals with disabilities and disadvantages to increas e their independence through employment OUALITATIVE DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY BENEFIT I Community Outreach for the Poor The following two descriptions represent significant progra ms provided by Good Samaritan Hospital, targeting the poor and underserved in the community Good Samaritan Hospital funds the Parish Nurse Ministry and Community Health Worker programs comprised of a dozen paid full time equivalents in nurses and community health worke rs. The team provides, at no charge, home visits to referred low income clients in nine neighborhoods. Clients include seniors and frail elderly in their homes or in congregate subsidized housing, the mentally and physically handicapped living alone or in group homes, and mothers who are pregnant or who have recently delivered a baby. Client contacts average between 500 to 800 per month. Referrals come from hospital care coordinators as well as o ther hospitals and community agencies. The team provides consistent health screenings, tea ches clients how to manage chronic illnesses and connects clients to support and assistance services. Parish Nurse and Community Health Workers along with four collaborating agencies address prematurity and low birth wei

Describe how the organization informs and educates patients and persons who may be billed for patient care about their eligibility for assistance under federal, state, or local government programs or under the organization's charity care policy. TriHealth, Inc. ("TriHealth") performs the billing services for all affiliated hospitals including The Good Samaritan Hospital of Cincinnati, Ohio. Brochures/Applications, provided in multiple languages, are visible and available in the registration and admitting areas of all TriHealth affiliated hospitals. In addition, the application is printed on the reverse side of a patient's bill with instructions on how to complete the application as well as how to return it. Financial counselors assist patients in completing the financial assistance application. Finally, TriHealth Inc. 's website contains information regarding its charity care and financial assistance programs with directions on how to contact the appropriate personnel to initiate an application or ask questions about the process.

If the organization is part of an affiliated health care system, describe the respective roles of the organization and its affiliates in promoting the health of the communities served. In 1995, The Good Samaritan Hospital of Cincinnati, Ohio and Bethesda Hospital, Inc. formed a partnership called TriHealth, Inc. to create an integrated health delivery system whose mission is to improve the health of the people they serve, with an emphasis on prevention, wellness and education. TriHealth, Inc.'s sites include two hospital locations and various physician office buildings throughout the Greater Cincinnati area in addition to fitness, rehabilitation, occupational health, palliative care services and outpatient centers. It also provides services in homes and workplaces and delivers care and education cooperatively through community-based organizations, such as churches, schools, clinics and social agencies. Almost fifteen years ago, TriHealth joined Catholic Health Initiatives, a national faith-based nonprofit health care organization with headquarters in Englewood, Colorado. CHI's exempt purpose is to serve as an integral part of its national system of hospitals and other charitable entities, which are described as market-based organizations, or MBOs. An MBO is a direct provider of care or services within a defined market area that may be an integrated health system and/or a stand-alone hospital or other facility or service provider. CHI serves as the parent corporation of its MBOs which are comprised of 73 hospitals, 40 long-term care, assisted- and residential-living facilities, and two community health-services organizations. Together, these facilities provided \$590 million in charity care and community benefit in the 2010 fiscal year, including services for the poor, free clinics, education and research
