AMONG OTHER THINGS, THE PACKET INCLUDES A COPY OF THE SLIDING FEE SCALE THAT IS USED TO DETERMINE THE AMOUNT THAT EACH CONSUMER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE TO PAY FOR EACH VISIT. AT INTAKE THE CONSUMER IS REQUIRED TO BRING IN VERIFICATION OF INCOME TO SUBSTANTIATE THEIR FINANCIAL NEED. THIS HELPS STAFF DETERMINE ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY AS WELL AS HELPS TO EDUCATE THE CONSUMER AGAIN ON THEIR ASSISTANCE LEVELS AND PAYMENT OPTIONS. AT THE END OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS THE CONSUMER INITIALS THAT THEY HAVE BEEN INFORMED OF THEIR CLIENT RESPONSIBILITY TO PAY AND THAT THEY UNDERSTAND THEIR ASSISTANCE LEVEL. THE THERAPISTS AND CASE FACILITATORS WORK WITH THE CONSUMERS TO ENSURE THAT THE CONSUMERS, WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR GOVERNMENT INSURANCE, ARE ENROLLED AND FULLY COVERED. THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER DOES NOT DENY SERVICE TO A CONSUMER BASED ON THEIR ABILITY TO PAY.

NORTHEASTERN CENTER OFFERS MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES IN FOUR PRIMARY NORTHEASTERN INDIANA COUNTIES, NOBLE, LAGRANGE, STEUBEN AND DEKALB. ALL FOUR COUNTIES ARE PRIMARILY RURAL WITH APPROXIMATELY 161,000 TOTAL RESIDENTS. THE MOST CURRENT AVAILABLE CENSUS BUREAU INFORMATION REPORTS THE AVERAGE HOUSEHOLD INCOME IS \$49,000 WITH APPROXIMATELY 10% OF RESIDENTS LIVING BELOW THE FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES. 40% OF ALL CONSUMERS SERVED IN 2010 WERE INSURED BY MEDICAID. THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER STRIVES TO BRING PROFESSIONAL STAFF TO THIS MEDICALLY UNDERSERVED COMMUNITY.

THE BOARD AND EMPLOYEES OF NORTHEASTERN CENTER WORK DILIGENTLY TO ENSURE THAT THE CENTER REMAINS A VIABLE COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER WITHIN THE COUNTIES. ALL ANNUAL SURPLUS FUNDS ARE REINVESTED BACK INTO THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FURTHER SERVICES AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH IN THE YEARS TO COME. THROUGH THESE SURPLUSES, THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER IS ABLE TO CONDUCT AND PARTICIPATE IN NUMEROUS COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. THE MAIN GOAL OF THESE ACTIVITIES IS TO INCREASE AWARENESS OF SERVICES, OVERCOME STIGMAS ASSOCIATED WITH MENTAL HEALTH, AND TO PRESENT SERVICE ACCESS TO THE COMMUNITY. COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES INCLUDE PROVIDING SCREENINGS AT VARIOUS COMMUNITY HEALTH FAIRS WITH AN EMPHASIS ON A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT AREAS INCLUDING GENERAL MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS, ADDICTIONS, GERIATRICS, ADOLESCENTS, EDUCATION AND CORPORATE EVENTS. THERE ARE NUMEROUS YOUTH EVENTS GEARED TOWARD MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS INCLUDING THE LOCAL SCIENCE FAIR SPONSORSHIP AND THE JANE GEORGE SCHOLARSHIP, WHICH PROVIDES A SCHOLARSHIP TO A LOCAL GRADUATING SENIOR PURSUING A CAREER IN MENTAL HEALTH. THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER ALSO PUT ON MORE THAN SIXTY PRESENTATIONS OF KIDS ON THE BLOCK AND LITTLE BEAR TO OVER 1,300 SCHOOL CHILDREN IN OUR FOUR COUNTY AREA. BOTH PROGRAMS FOCUS ON CHALLENGES SIGNIFICANT TO CHILDREN, SUCH AS CHILD ABUSE, BULLYING AND DRUG USE. THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER IS FACED WITH SEVERAL SERVICE HURDLES DUE TO ITS RURAL SERVICE AREA. RECRUITMENT OF QUALIFIED STAFF INCLUDING PHYSICIANS IS AN ONGOING CHALLENGE. THE NORTHEASTERN CENTER WORKS DILIGENTLY TO HIRE QUALITY MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS TO PROVIDE SERVICES TO A POPULATION WHO IS GREATLY UNDER SERVED. THE OTHER LARGE CHALLENGE IS CONSUMER TRANSPORTATION. WITH LITTLE OPTION FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, NORTHEASTERN CENTER MAINTAINS ITS OWN FLEET OF VANS WHICH TRANSPORTS CONSUMERS TO VARIOUS PROGRAMS AND APPOINTMENTS. IN ADDITION, NORTHEASTERN CENTER IS REWARDED WITH MANY VOLUNTEER DRIVERS WHO TRAVEL MORE THAN 10,000 MILES PER YEAR TRANSPORTING CONSUMERS.
