It is the Board's policy to pay the presidents for the taxes associated with this income. 4 HOUSING ALLOWANCE OR RESIDENCE FOR PERSONAL USE. For efficiency, residences near RI headquarters are provided for Rotary International's president and president-elect. Personal use of the residences is reported as taxable income to the recipients. In addition, RI reimburses the president and president-elect for certain costs associated with maintaining their personal residences while they are traveling on behalf of the association. These expense reimbursements are taxable to the recipients. 5 HEALTH OR SOCIAL CLUB DUES OR INITIATION FEES. For the president and president-elect, expenses related to maintaining club memberships are included under the Rotary Code of Policies for personal expenses reimbursement. T
