There are two grants that are given out annually the Book Nursing Scholarship awards which are for nurses furthering their education (18 awards @ \$1,500/each) and student volunteer awards for education (5 awards at \$1,000/each). These awards are made directly to the colleges for each of the student's accounts. When awarding grants to affiliated organizations, Edward Hospital & Naperville Psychiatric Ventures, all of these awards must be approved by the Executive Director of the Edward Foundation and the accounting department as to correct usage of the funds for designated purposes in the restricted accounts and approval by the EF Board for unrestricted accounts.
