
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

Programs include counseling, employment services, life skills, food pantries, emergency assistance and trinsitional housing that focus on: providing supportive housing that is affordable and helps mitigate factors that lead to homelessness such as low income, substance abuse, health issues, and aging. Create financial stability through education and employment services such as job preparedness and training. Optimize services for individuals such as seniors and the developmentally disabled so they can continue to live independently. Community in Schools is a collaborative program between Peoria Public Schools and Heart of Illinois United Way partner agencies that administers substance abuse, violence prevention and mental health programs for students in kindergarten through high school. Each position has a salary range that is updated based on current pay studies and employee pay rates are based on these ranges.
